COVID-19: All attendees must practice social distancing and a mask must be worn at all times when you are not over the wall attending to your race car. This is especially important on Saturday. Face mask, mouth and nose covering is required in all buildings and outside when walking around. If you leave your social circle outside, a mask will be required. That means if you leave pit lane, your paddock spot, or enter any building you will be REQUIRED to wear a mask. Over the wall during a pit stop, no mask required. But that could change, or the details of who may be required to wear a mask. Drivers with their helmets going in and coming out of car exempt, because they have their helmet on. Daytona safety and fire are asking the drivers to keep their helmet on when riding in the ambulance etc. to use as a face covering.

Reading the rules is required by all CCES drivers, crew and car builders.

COVID-19: All attendees must practice social distancing and a mask must be worn at all times when you are not over the wall attending to your race car. This is especially important on Saturday.

Entrance Gate 70; Must have Admittance Wristband to enter. This wristband will be available from 10:00 AM - 7:00 PM on Saturday and 5:00 AM - 1:00 PM on Sunday. To receive the wristband you must print off and sign the 5 (five pages) waivers (on the last pages, additional waiver packs available at) and bring them with you to Gate 70. You will then turn in your waiver, receive your wristband and have your temperature taken. Anyone who is 100 degrees or warmer will be pulled off to the side for further screening. If your temperature is still showing 100 degrees or warmer after further screening you will not be allowed entry into the Speedway. You will be subjected to temperature checks every time you pass through the gate. You must keep the Admittance Wristband on all weekend. 24-hour gate coverage.

Pit Vehicles: No pit vehicles, golf carts, bicycles, scooters or anything other than a car or your feet on Saturday. These are IMSA's rules we must follow.

Garages: Garages are sold out.

ChampCar has the Blue Garages. IMSA has the Yellow Garages. If you have a blue garage you will NOT have paddock parking available in the garage area. You will need to unload your car and tools in your garage then drop your trailer in the trailer drop/overflow paddock area. This will need to be done as quickly as possible since we will be loading in all teams to the blue garages. If you do not have a garage you will receive a paddock parking spot in the blue garage area. The paddock spots are narrow so you will not be able to pull your car next to the trailer or have any slide outs or canopies up. If you require more room you may set up in the overflow paddock. Since we lost half the garages this setup will give everyone the opportunity to have a location close to pit road for repairs, tools, etc. This will also speed the process when DIS Rescue needs to drop cars off in the paddock that have been towed in from the course. Garages will be locked up at 7PM on Saturday evening and reopened at 5AM Sunday morning.

Paddock: One space per team. No electric. Limited lighting. Paddock closes and is locked up at 7:00pm Saturday night.

Pitlane Electric: Electrical hookups are limited.

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Pit Passes: Only drivers and essential crew are allowed on pitlane. You must show your pit/driver band to get on pitlane.

Guest Pass: No Guests are allowed on the DIS property. Only drivers and essential crew.

Pets: Pets are allowed into the DIS facility must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

Children: No children under 18 unless they are part of the team. You MUST email mike.morrison@champcar.org to get the special minor waivers. These can not be done the day of the race. They must be done prior to arriving.

Camping: Only at Lake Lloyd Shores. \$75 for the weekend. ChampCar will have a person at the entrance to the camping lot who will take payment for your spot and issue you a parking permit that will need to be displayed on your dash for the entire weekend. DO NOT call the track to reserve a spot. There is plenty of room for ChampCar teams in the lot for camping and motorhomes. The camping area restroom will NOT be open.
Cash or credit cards accepted.

Camping / Camper Hookups: Available at Lake Lloyd Shores. Included with your \$75 camping fee. The camping area restroom will NOT be open.

Barbecues: NO Large Groups. Try to keep the socializing to your immediate social group. BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Showers will not be open. Restrooms in the blue garage and near ChampCar RV/Camping will be open and staffed with attendants (required). They will be opened the same as the garage / paddock hours. No restrooms will be open after 7:00pm on Saturday and will be open during ChampCars event on Sunday.

Concessions: TBD. Most likely will not be open so please make other plans.

Fuel on site: None. There are several gas stations near the track.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

Event Guidelines

- The following policies are subject to change based on local government guidelines in relation to COVID-19.
- All published local guidelines will be on hand for easy reference.
- ChampCar asks that anyone who is at higher risk for severe illness, feeling unwell, or who has been in contact with anyone that is sick in the last two weeks would stay home.
- If you are healthy, but uncomfortable being around other people for fear of illness, it may be better if you skip the event. ChampCar will happily refund your entry fee or move your fee to another event later in the year.
- Event is closed to spectators. It is advisable that non-participating personnel do not accompany the team to the event.
- While ChampCar is not limiting the number of team members per car in attendance, each track may have restrictions that we must follow. Please read the supplemental rules for each event to see if such restrictions exist.
- ChampCar recommends all participants follow current CDC guidelines on social distancing and personal protective gear. Signs will be placed around the venue to remind people of social distancing and protective health protocols. Teams are responsible for determining which types of protective gear (mask, gloves, etc.) they choose to use and for bringing sufficient supplies for themselves.
- ChampCar will work with the track to have frequently touched surfaces such as tables, counters, doorknobs, light switches, etc. cleaned with disinfectant at regular intervals.
- ChampCar will ensure there are plenty of hand washing stations and/or hand sanitizers in and around the facility, particularly high traffic areas.
- Only essential workers are allowed in specialty work areas such as timing & scoring and race control.

Tech

- Only one team member (preferably the captain) may bring the car to tech.
- Bring your completely filled out tech form with you.
- Required decals will be available and set out on a table so you can pick up your own.
- We ask that you maintain six feet of distance from our tech inspectors.
- ChampCar will place less cars into the tech bay than normal to help maintain greater distances between people.

Gear Tech

- Arrive at gear tech fully suited up in your driver gear, carrying your helmet.
- ChampCar will hand you a gear check decal for you to apply on your own helmet.

Registration

- Only the captain is permitted to be at registration.
- If possible, complete all payments before arriving to registration.
- Registration line will be marked to maintain social distancing.
- Bring the team's completed COVID-19 waivers with you (no waiver = no driver band).
- Bring completed tech sheet and/or log book with you.
- Hard surfaces will be disinfected throughout the day.

Drivers Meeting

- Driver meetings will be held outside and comply with social distance protocols. The meetings will also be simultaneously broadcast both by FM transmitter as well as on the ChampCar YouTube Live channel. If a track does not allow public meetings of any kind, ChampCar will hold driver meetings exclusively over an FM transmitter and/or the ChampCar YouTube Live channel.
- Questions will be fielded as usual from in person participants as well as by YouTube chat.

Pit Road

- Some events may limit the number of people on pit road. Read the supplemental event rules for info. Even with no restrictions, ChampCar advises teams to not load up their pit boxes with extra people.
- Drivers will still be checked for arm bands at pit out. Please have your band ready to display to our pit out worker.
- Drivers will still need to report to Black Flag at pit in for on-track driving infractions. A ChampCar staff member will write out the infraction and place it on your windshield for you to read.
- All fueling rules remain in place.

Award Ceremony

- Award ceremony will be held outside, and social distancing protocols will be followed.

- Social distancing will be in place. Maintain 6' between you and others outside of your social group.
- We will enter Gate 70 on Saturday. The gate MAY open earlier than it is now on the schedule. There will be 6 lanes open. Three lanes on Sunday. Everyone will have their temps taken. temps everytime you come back into the track. We are awaiting what the max temp will be. That should come next week.
- You will be required to have 4 waivers pre-signed to get in... 2x CCES, 2x Daytona. One set is included in the back of this packet. Additional forms can be downloaded at <https://champcar.org/events>
- NO CHAMPCAR Spectators. ONLY drivers and essential crew. No children.
- Drivers meeting and New to ChampCar Meeting will be virtual. Drivers meeting will be posted about a week out from the event. Visit <https://champcar.org/mainweb/news/driversmeeting> to see video
- Camping is in the Lake Lloyd camping area. RV Spot / Tent / whatever you decide that fits the motorhome sized spot. \$75. We get the tunnel side of the Lake Lloyd parking area, IMSA on the other. We charge \$75, IMSA is charging \$700 from what I understand.
- No one allowed in race control tower. Only Daytona, IMSA, SCCA, CCES staff, CCES Broadcast crew.
- Photo credentials - We will limit photographers / videographers to credentialed only. I have a short list right now. MSM, GRM, SCI. and the local paper. No TEAM Photogs will be allowed to be outside their pits/paddock spots, so they don't need photo credentials. Refer to the part about drivers and essential crew only. Email bill.strong@champcar.org for more info.
- Registration is in the 500 club. Limit access to captains only. Practice social distancing. Swag will be sold. Masks required.
- Garages. 1st come first given out. They are sold out. 60 garages only. We are in the Blue Garage area. Outside of those 60 you will be in a specified paddock area.
- Registration is limited to the captain, please take care of all payments before the event.
- Face mask, mouth and nose covering is required in all buildings and outside when walking around. If you leave your social circle outside, a mask will be required. That means if you leave pit lane, your paddock spot, or enter any building you will be REQUIRED to wear a mask. Over the wall during a pit stop, no mask required. But that could change, or the details of who may be required to wear a mask. Drivers with their helmets going in and coming out of car exempt, because they have their helmet on.
- It is VERY important that this is followed by everyone. NASCAR/IMSA/NBC SPORTS TV cameras will be all over the place on Saturday.

Pre-Tech Inspection by Skype

For those individuals who are concerned about interacting with ChampCar tech staff and the transfer of germs/viruses/bacteria, ChampCar is offering Pre-Tech by Skype from the safety of your own garage. This is a full vehicle inspection done the same way as it would be done in person. If you are interested in this service here's how to sign up:

- Ensure you have what is needed to do a video call (high speed internet connection, camera, audio).
- Contact jay.mauney@champcar.org and request an appointment. Appointments are limited so don't wait too long.
- Print out a ChampCar tech sheet and completely fill it out before your meeting.
- At your tech appointment you will show Tech all aspects of your car and answer any questions tech has. If your car passes inspection, Jay will send you an email confirming your success.
- When you arrive at the track have one team member drive your car to tech and pull into the line marked "Pre-Tech Cars". A ChampCar tech official will ask for your confirmation email. No email and they will ask you to move to the regular line.
- With your email in hand, the ChampCar tech official will walk around your car one time to confirm everything from your Skype call is there. They will then place an annual tech decal on your car and you are done and ready to race.

Despite the nature of this inspection being via teleconference, all the same rules and policies apply. You are required to disclose all details of your car. If aspects of your car are hidden and later discovered at the track, whether at pre-tech confirmation, post race impound or anywhere in between, you can be moved to EC or disqualified or removed from the track. Our hope is that this new option can alleviate the fears some of you may have about direct contact this summer and help speed up our current tech process.

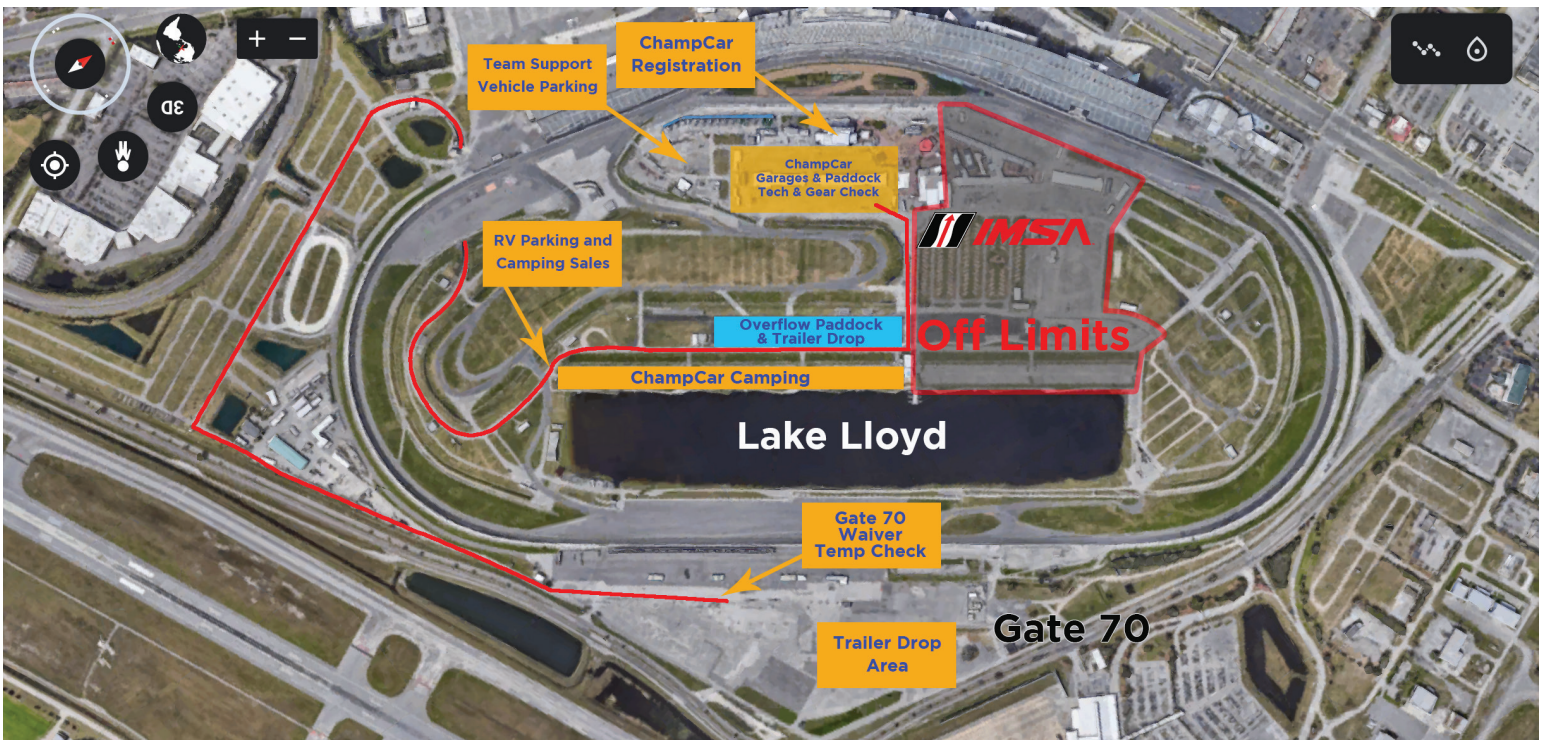

Staging and event entrance will be at Gate 70. Everyone must pre-print their waivers, sign, and use them as your ticket to get into the track. Your temperature will be taken before you enter the track. There will be six lanes open at Gate 70 on Saturday, and 3 on Sunday.

Temps will be taken Saturday and Sunday.

Masks will be required to enter the track.



Florida Governor's Actions Regarding Travel <https://floridahealthcovid19.gov/travelers/> Executive Order Number 20-82

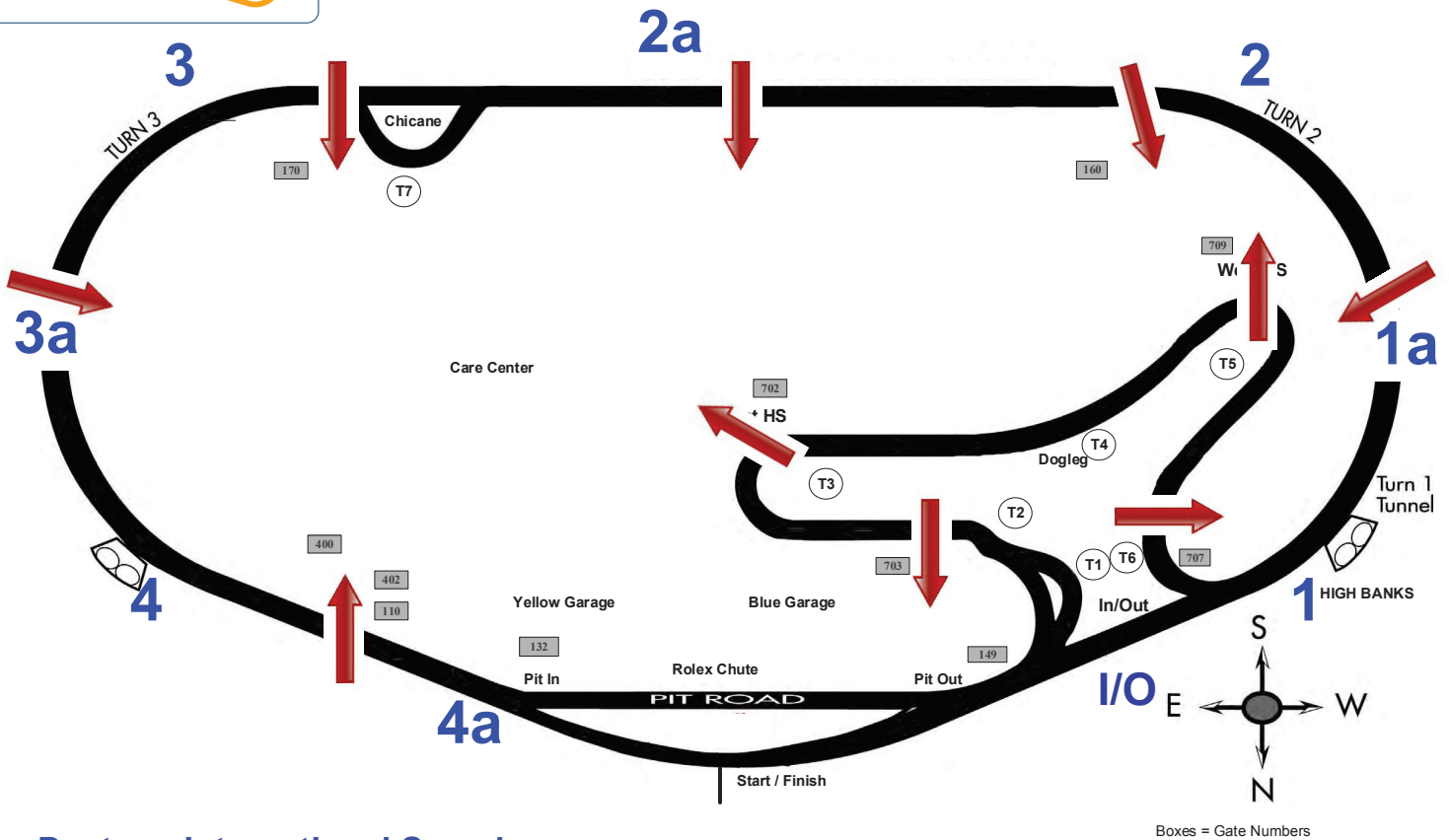
Governor DeSantis directed all individuals entering the state of Florida from the New York Tri-State Area (Connecticut, New Jersey, and New York) to isolate or quarantine for a period of 14 days from the time of entry into Florida or the duration of the individual's presence in Florida, whichever is shorter. This includes persons entering Florida by roadways.

This order was extended in Section 3 of Executive Order Number 20-139 (Effective on June 5th).

This Executive Order does not apply to individuals involved in commercial activity and students traveling for the purpose of academic work, internships, sports training and any other activity or program approved by the educational institution.

All persons isolating or quarantining will be responsible for all costs associated with their isolation or quarantine. This includes transportation, lodging, food, medical care and any other expenses to sustain the individual during their period of isolation or quarantine.

Roadside checkpoints are set up on interstates to check for potential COVID-19 cases coming into Florida from areas with substantial community spread of the virus. The checkpoints do not apply to commercial drivers or health workers.



Daytona International Speedway

The track was built in 1959 by NASCAR founder William "Bill" France, Sr. to host racing that was held at the former Daytona Beach Road Course. His banked design permitted higher speeds and gave fans a better view of the cars. Lights were installed around the track in 1998, and today it is the third-largest single lit outdoor sports facility. The speedway has been renovated four times, with the infield renovated in 2004 and the track repaved in 1978 and 2010.

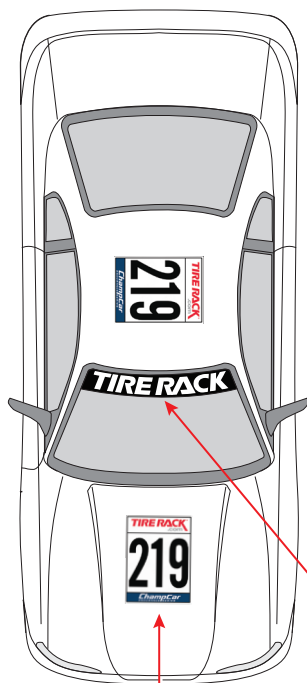

The following examples are approved installation locations for the required decal package.

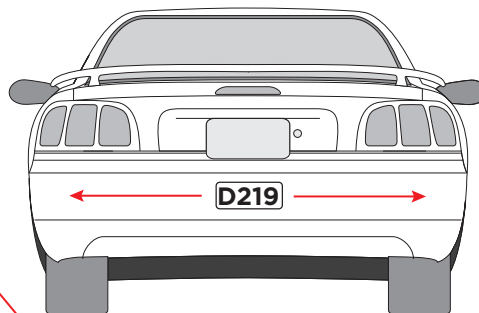

Maxxis tire contingency decal on left and right side front fenders.
NOT needed if you are not using Maxxis VR-1 Tires.
 Available at Event Tech Inspection.

Place sponsor and number panel as shown between arrows.

They **MUST** be displayed as in the image above. You may cut out the sponsor decals, but they must remain in the vertical alignment, and be in the same order. Failure to do so could keep your team from starting the race until they are fixed. 2020 requires that you add the Bell helmet decal below the Frozen Rotor decal. Bell decals will be available at tech.



Additional event specific decals may be required at certain events. Instruction on placement of those decals will be available at the event and in the ChampCar Event Supplementals. Most likely place for the decals will be above the class letter on the doors.

If you have a custom wrap, please make arrangements for the required ChampCar decals in your design.

The number panel design will allow you to remove the top and lower Sponsor/ChampCar sections if you race with other sanctioning bodies. Just visit tech when you return to ChampCar to get new upper and lower sections of the number panel for free.

Replacements available at Tech & Registration on race weekends. Limited quantities available.

Convertibles and topless cars only. May face forward or toward drivers right like on the roof.

Only official ChampCar Decals will be allowed through tech. Do not print your own.

Official decal locations and order are required and are not a suggestion.

You will not be allowed to enter the track until decals are in the required locations.

Windshield banner is required at the top of the window. The background is optional. Per the BCCR, do not use white, orange, or yellow backgrounds. Cars without front windshields must have the decal at the top of the hood. The letters can be arranged to the curvature of the window. Team sponsor decals may go below the TireRack decal.

1. Affirm that I have not been diagnosed with, demonstrated any symptoms of or have in any way been exposed to any communicable diseases (including but not limited to the virus commonly referred to as COVID-19) within the past thirty days;
2. Acknowledge that I am aware that by entering the premises and participating in the EVENT(S) that there are risks to me and to those with whom I interact of exposure, directly or indirectly, to communicable disease(s) including but not limited to the virus "severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2)", "COVID-19" and/or any mutation or variation thereof;
3.
