ESN 2 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

Ohio / Nelson Ledges Road Course Pandemic Requirements

- Face mask, mouth, and nose covering is required in all buildings, and outside when walking around, or in your paddock, or pitlane. Over the wall during a pit stop, when not fueling (fueling requires helmets etc), a face cover is required. Drivers with their helmets on with face shield down going in and coming out of car exempt; because they have their helmet on.
- It is VERY important that these rules are followed by everyone.
 - Mask =
 - Helmet with face shield
 - Balaclava
 - Face Shield (PPE style, grinding, etc)
 - Neck Gaiter
 - Bandana
 - Medical style face mask, cloth or paper.

Reading the rules is required by all CCES drivers, crew and car builders.

ChampCar.Live! : Watch the race from start to finish with live commentary. Visit ChampCar.Live

Test & Tune Information: Friday practice will be from 9:00am till noon (1 hour lunch break), 1:00pm till 5pm. Cost is \$250 per team (unlimited drivers). Payment will be at the gate. A two hour session in both am and pm, for fuel calculation. Arrival on Thursday evening is recommended .

Garages: None.

Paddock: The paddock is all grass. Bring plywood to put under your car, jack, and jackstands. During rain conditions the paddock can turn into a mud bowl. Be prepared with easyups and ground cover. The cold side of pit lane is also a good place to use plywood on the ground to keep your shoes dry and less muddy.

Warning: When choosing your paddock location, chose higher elevation areas as water collects in the low areas. Pay attention to the weather.

Lighting: VERY limited. Bring your own pit and paddock lighting and generators.

Electrical Hookups in Pit / Paddock: NONE. Bring your own power sources.

Pit Passes: ChampCar racers and their crew will have access with the issued wristbands. Nelson Ledges plans to allow spectators during the event and to charge them separately. So please wear your correct wristbands to prevent confusion during the event.

Pets: Pets allowed into the track must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

Children: Small children (infants, toddlers, etc) are not permitted in the pit area. Children under the age of 16 must be under adult supervision.

Camping: Overnight Camping. Self-contained RV camping is allowed Friday thru Sunday. There are no hook-up sites. Space in the paddock is limited, teams may camp in the paddock, however teams with both a hauler and a separate camper are advised to park their camper in the over-flow area.

Camping / Camper Hookups: There are no hook-up campsites. All camping must be self contained.

Barbeques: BBQ's are allowed in the transporter parking area and thirty feet (30') outside the cold pit area, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Bathrooms / Showers: There are some bathroom facilities onsite. However, Nelson Ledges is planning to renovate them to increase the number and add showers. If the renovations are not complete, portable bathrooms and showers will be supplied.

Gate: The front gate will be open overnight during the event.

Concessions: The Slp Truck - "Put Some Pork on your Fork!"

Guest Pass: Teams are advised that all team members, family, and guests who desire Pit Lane access MUST purchase a Pit Pass through ChampCar at the track. \$20 will purchase a weekend ChampCar Temporary Membership pass. ChampCar members can obtain a free pit pass by showing their membership card.

Fuel on site: Fuel. 93 octane pump-gas is available on site. Keep your fuel jugs, drums, and containers covered if it rains. Water in your fuel will ruin your weekend.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather. See paddock info above.

Drones: Unmanned aircraft systems and drones are prohibited at ChampCar Endurance events at all times.

Damage Fees:

Damaged guard rail replacement - \$1,000.00 per section
Damaged concrete barrier replacement - \$1,000.00 per section
Damaged tire wall bundle replacement - \$500.00 per bundle
Damaged debris fencing replacement - \$1,000 per section
Damaged conveyor belting replacement - \$100.00 per foot
Damaged catch fence post replacement - \$100.00 per post
Fire incident - \$300.00 per fire bottle
Damaged tow strap - \$50 per tow strap
Oil dry - \$10 per bag

Event Guidelines

- The following policies are subject to change based on local government guidelines in relation to COVID-19.
- All published local guidelines will be on hand for easy reference.
- ChampCar asks that anyone who is at higher risk for severe illness, feeling unwell, or who has been in contact with anyone that is sick in the last two weeks would stay home.
- If you are healthy, but uncomfortable being around other people for fear of illness, it may be better if you skip the event. ChampCar will happily move your entry fee to another event later in the year.
- Event is closed to spectators. It is advisable that non-participating personnel do not accompany the team to the event.
- While ChampCar is not limiting the number of team members per car in attendance, each track may have restrictions that we must follow. Please read the supplemental rules for each event to see if such restrictions exist.
- ChampCar recommends all participants follow current CDC guidelines on social distancing and personal protective gear. Signs will be placed around the venue to remind people of social distancing and protective health protocols. Teams are responsible for determining which types of protective gear (mask, gloves, etc.) they choose to use and for bringing sufficient supplies for themselves.
- ChampCar will work with the track to have frequently touched surfaces such as tables, counters, doorknobs, light switches, etc. cleaned with disinfectant at regular intervals.
- ChampCar will ensure there are plenty of hand washing stations and/or hand sanitizers in and around the facility, particularly high traffic areas.
- Only essential workers are allowed in specialty work areas such as timing & scoring and race control.

Tech

- Only one team member (preferably the captain) may bring the car to tech.
- Bring your completely filled out tech form with you.
- Required decals will be available and set out on a table so you can pick up your own.
- We ask that you maintain six feet of distance from our tech inspectors.
- ChampCar will place less cars into the tech bay than normal to help maintain greater distances between people.

Gear Tech

- Arrive at gear tech fully suited up in your driver gear, carrying your helmet.
- ChampCar will hand you a gear check decal for you to apply on your own helmet.

Registration

- Only the captain is permitted to be at registration.
- If possible, complete all payments before arriving to registration.
- Registration line will be marked to maintain social distancing.
- Bring the team's completed COVID-19 waivers with you (no waiver = no driver band).
- Bring completed tech sheet and/or log book with you.
- Hard surfaces will be disinfected throughout the day.

Drivers Meeting

- Driver meetings will be held outside and comply with social distance protocols. The meetings will also be simultaneously broadcast both by FM transmitter as well as on the ChampCar YouTube Live channel. If a track does not allow public meetings of any kind, ChampCar will hold driver meetings exclusively over an FM transmitter and/or the ChampCar YouTube Live channel.
- Questions will be fielded as usual from in person participants as well as by YouTube chat.

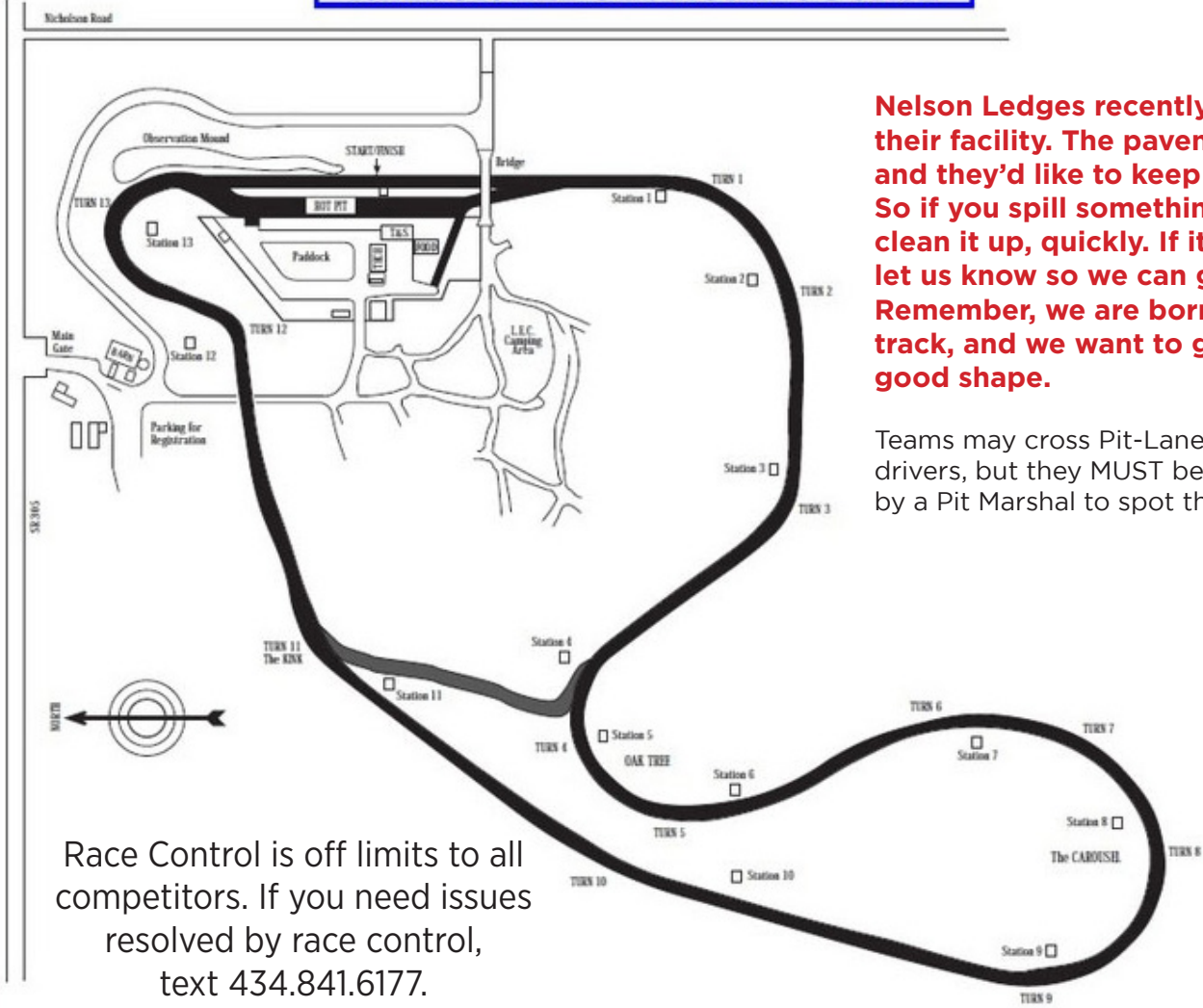
Pit Road

- Some events may limit the number of people on pit road. Read the supplemental event rules for info. Even with no restrictions, ChampCar advises teams to not load up their pit boxes with extra people.
- Drivers will still be checked for arm bands at pit out. Please have your band ready to display to our pit out worker.
- Drivers will still need to report to Black Flag at pit in for on-track driving infractions. A ChampCar staff member will write out the infraction and place it on your windshield for you to read.
- All fueling rules remain in place.

Award Ceremony

- Award ceremony will be held outside, and social distancing protocols will be followed.

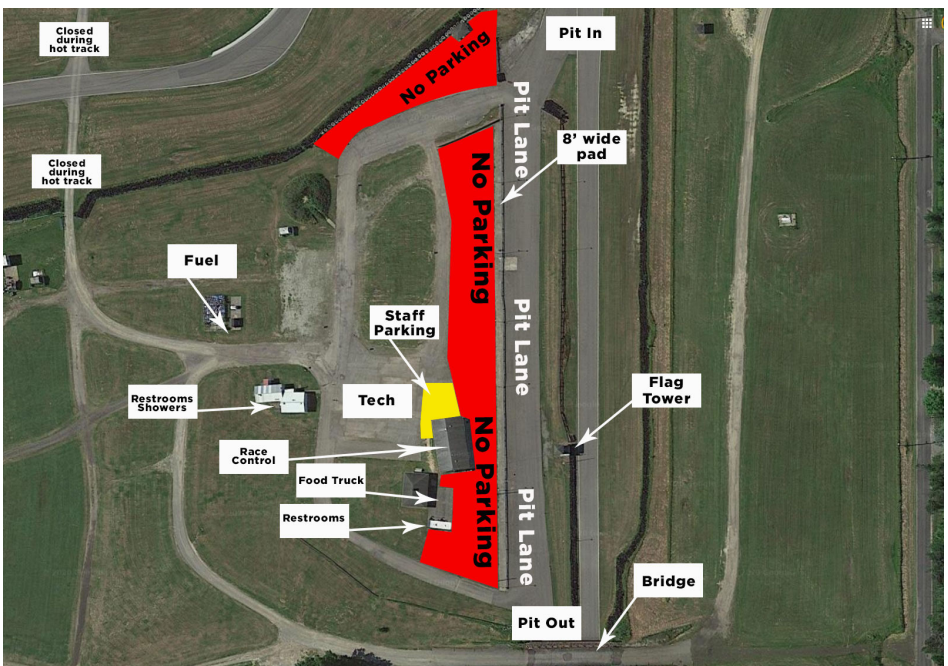
NELSON LEDGES ROAD COURSE

 Unmanned Aircraft Systems and Drones are Prohibited at ChampCar Endurance Series Events

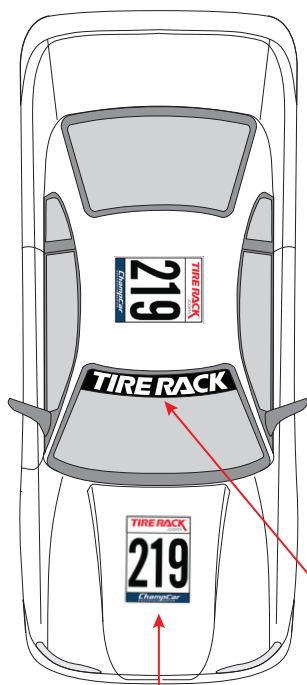

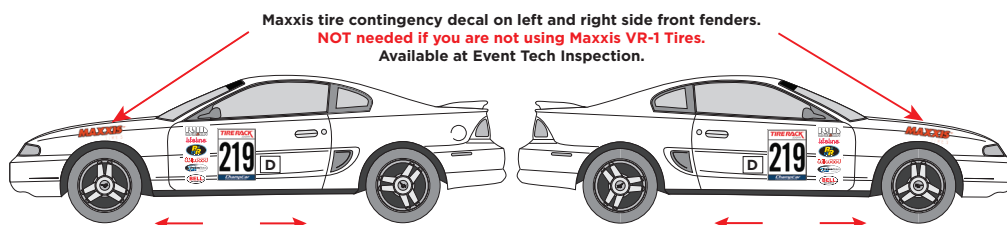
Convertibles and topless cars only. May face forward or toward drivers right like on the roof.

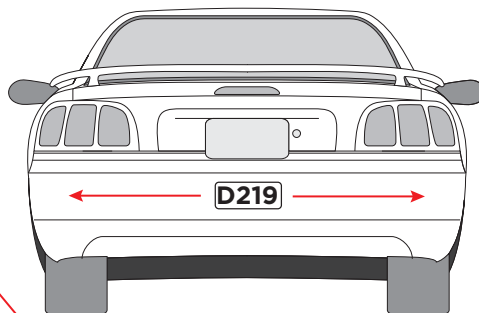
Only official ChampCar Decals will be allowed through tech. Do not print your own.

Official decal locations and order are required and are not a suggestion.

You will not be allowed to enter the track until decals are in the required locations.



Place sponsor and number panel as shown between arrows. They MUST be displayed as in the image above. You may cut out the sponsor decals, but they must remain in the vertical alignment, and be in the same order. Failure to do so could keep your team from starting the race until they are fixed. 2020 requires that you add the Bell helmet decal below the Frozen Rotor decal. Bell decals will be available at tech.



Windshield banner is required at the top of the window. The background is optional. Per the BCCR, do not use white, orange, or yellow backgrounds. Cars without front windshields must have the decal at the top of the hood. The letters can be arranged to the curvature of the window. Team sponsor decals may go below the TireRack decal.

Additional event specific decals may be required at certain events. Instruction on placement of those decals will be available at the event and in the ChampCar Event Supplementals. Most likely place for the decals will be above the class letter on the doors.

If you have a custom wrap, please make arrangements for the required ChampCar decals in your design.

The number panel design will allow you to remove the top and lower Sponsor/ChampCar sections if you race with other sanctioning bodies. Just visit tech when you return to ChampCar to get new upper and lower sections of the number panel for free.

Waiver and Wristbands: In order to enter the facility, every driver and crew member must pre-print and sign each of the 2 (2) waiver pages.
One signature per driver/crew per waiver.

- ChampCar Communicable Disease Related Hold harmless, release, waiver of liability, and indemnity agreement
- ChampCar Release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement
- You will sign the Nelson Waiver when you enter the track. Hand them the CCES waivers then.

This will be your ticket to enter the event. You will not be allowed to enter the facility without this waiver. Go to <https://champcar.org/register/events.php> to print additional waivers.

No one – including any employee or event member – who has experienced any of the following symptoms at any time during the 14 days preceding event, or who is a household member, intimate partner or caregiver of anyone who has experienced these symptoms, may enter the property:

- fever
- cough
- shortness of breath
- persistent pain or pressure in chest
- confusion, or bluish lips or face.

Any Renter or crew member who is or has experienced any of the above symptoms must notify CMS/ChampCar immediately. Anyone who begins experiencing any of the above symptoms during an event must leave the facility immediately.

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work, or participate in any way in the EVENT(S), I for myself, my personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin:

1. Affirm that I have not been diagnosed with, demonstrated any symptoms of or have in any way been exposed to any communicable diseases (including but not limited to the virus commonly referred to as COVID-19) within the past thirty days;
2. Acknowledge that I am aware that by entering the premises and participating in the EVENT(S) that there are risks to me and to those with whom I interact of exposure, directly or indirectly, to communicable disease(s) including but not limited to the virus "severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2)", "COVID-19" and/or any mutation or variation thereof;

HEREBY voluntarily agree to RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE and COVENANT NOT TO SUE on behalf of myself or on behalf of others with whom I interact, the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations or any subdivision thereof, track operators, track owners, officials, competition vehicle owners, drivers, pit crews, rescue personnel, any persons in any RESTRICTED AREA, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and leasees of premises used to conduct the EVENT(S), premises and event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions, or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or EVENT(S) and each of them, their directors, officers, agents and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "Releasees", from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefor, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise;
4. HEREBY agree to INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur arising out of or related to my illness or death, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.
