Waiver and Wristbands: ALL drivers and crew must report to the ticket window at registration to sign the waiver and receive a waiver wristband. You will not be allowed access to the track without this wristband. Only the team captain needs to check in at registration to receive driver and crew credentials.

Test & Tune Information: \$350 per team. Entrants must be entered in the ChampCar event. Register here

Pit Vehicles: There will be a \$25 Pit Vehicle Pass for golf carts, scooters, etc..

Garages: Garages are available for rent. They are \$400 for the weekend and can accommodate more than one car. Contact Road America for details. 920-892-4576

Paddock: No electric. Limited lighting. One space per team. Included with your race entry fee.

Paddock Electric: There are no electrical hook ups in the paddock.

Pitlane Electric: Road America will be selling power hook-ups for pit road during registration at the ticket counter. \$25 for electric on pit road.

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Pit Passes: Teams are advised that all team members, family, and guests who desire Pit Lane access MUST purchase a Weekend Membership Pass through ChampCar at the track. ChampCar members can obtain a free pit pass by showing their membership card.

Guest Pass: Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the ticket counter and watch the race for \$20. Children 17 and under free.

Pets: Pets are not allowed at Road America.

Children: Children must be under adult supervision at all times. Children under 18 are not allowed on pit road.

Camping: RV camping in the paddock is allowed on Thursday and Friday night. The cost is \$50. Contact Road America for details. 920-892-4576

Camping / Camper Hookups: Contact Road America for details. 920-892-4576

Cabins: Cabins are available to rent for 3 nights and are \$750 plus a \$400 refundable damage deposit or for 2 nights and are \$550, plus a \$400 refundable damage deposit.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes. Restrooms and showers are available in the paddock.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: St. Johns concessions stand will be open on Friday - Sunday.

Fuel on site: The fuel pumps will be open.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

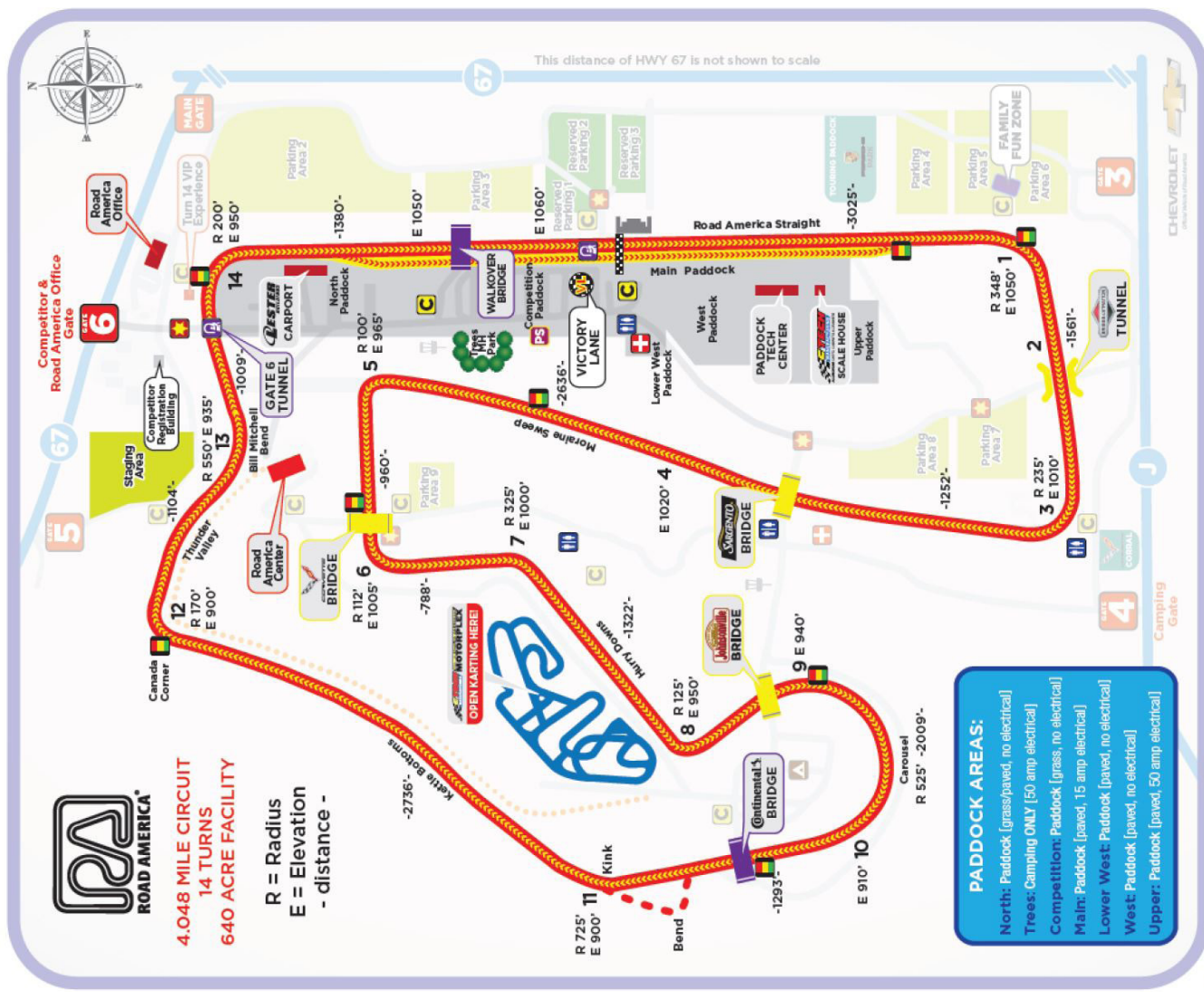
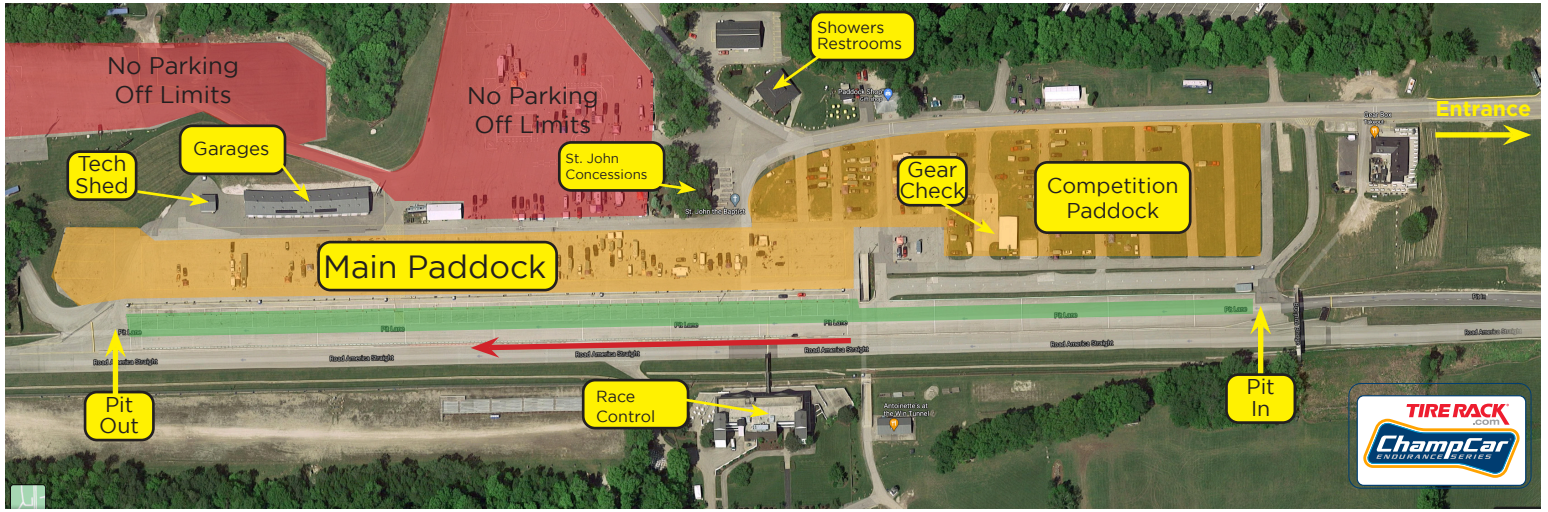

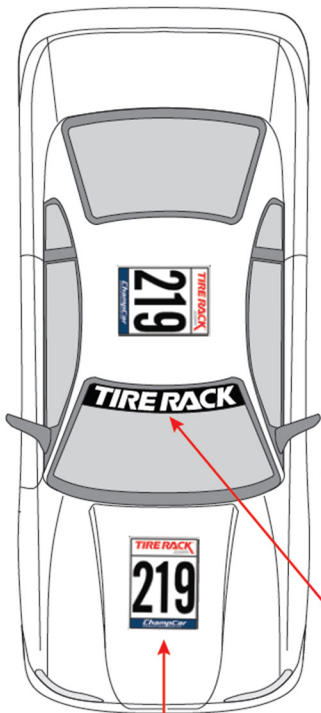

Decal Installation & Location Instructions

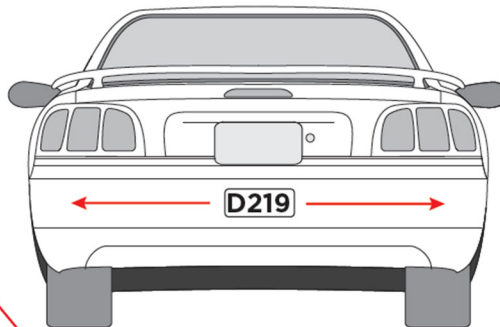
The following examples are approved installation locations for the required decal package.

Maxxis tire contingency decal on left and right side front fenders.
NOT needed if you are not using Maxxis VR-1 Tires.
 Available at Event Tech Inspection.

Place sponsor and number panel as shown between arrows. They **MUST** be displayed as in the image above. You may cut out the sponsor decals, but they must remain in the vertical alignment, and be in the same order. Failure to do so could keep your team from starting the race until they are fixed.



Additional event specific decals may be required at certain events. Instruction on placement of those decals will be available at the event and in the ChampCar Event Supplements. Most likely place for the decals will be above the class letter on the doors.

If you have a custom wrap, please make arrangements for the required ChampCar decals in your design.

Convertibles and topless cars only. May face forward or toward drivers right like on the roof.

Windshield banner is required at the top of the window. The background is optional. Per the BCCR, do not use white, orange, or yellow backgrounds. Cars without front windshields must have the decal at the top of the hood. The letters can be arranged to the curvature of the window. Team sponsor decals may go below the Tire Rack decal.

The number panel design will allow you to remove the top and lower Sponsor/ChampCar sections if you race with other sanctioning bodies. Just visit tech when you return to ChampCar to get new upper and lower sections of the number panel for free.

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work, or participate in any way in the EVENT(S), I for myself, my personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin:

1. Affirm that I have not been diagnosed with, demonstrated any symptoms of or have in any way been exposed to any communicable diseases (including but not limited to the virus commonly referred to as COVID-19) within the past thirty days;
2. Acknowledge that I am aware that by entering the premises and participating in the EVENT(S) that there are risks to me and to those with whom I interact of exposure, directly or indirectly, to communicable disease(s) including but not limited to the virus "severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2)", "COVID-19" and/or any mutation or variation thereof;
3. HEREBY voluntarily agree to RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE and COVENANT NOT TO SUE on behalf of myself or on behalf of others with whom I interact, the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations or any subdivision thereof, track operators, track owners, officials, competition vehicle owners, drivers, pit crews, rescue personnel, any persons in any RESTRICTED AREA, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and leasees of premises used to conduct the EVENT(S), premises and event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions, or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or EVENT(S) and each of them, their directors, officers, agents and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "Releasees", from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefor, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise;
4. HEREBY agree to INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur arising out of or related to my illness or death, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work, or participate in any way in the EVENT(S) or being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (defined as any area requiring special authorization, credentials, or permission to enter or any area to which admission by the general public is restricted or prohibited), EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself, his personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin:

1. Acknowledges, agrees, and represents that he has or will immediately upon entering any of such RESTRICTED AREAS, and will continuously thereafter, inspect the RESTRICTED AREAS which he enters, and he further agrees and warrants that, if at any time, he is in or about RESTRICTED AREAS and he feels anything to be unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and if necessary will leave the RESTRICTED AREAS and/or refuse to participate further in the EVENT(S).
2. HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations or any subdivision thereof, track operators, track owners, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, rescue personnel, any persons in any RESTRICTED AREA, sponsors, advertisers, owners and leasees of premises used to conduct the EVENT(S), premises and event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions, or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or EVENT(S) and each of them, their directors, officers, agents, employees, representatives, owners, members, affiliates, successors and assigns all for the purposes herein referred to as "Releasees," FROM ALL LIABILITY TO THE UNDERSIGNED, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin FOR ANY AND ALL LOSS OR DAMAGE, AND ANY CLAIM OR DEMANDS THEREFOR ON ACCOUNT OF INJURY TO THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OR RESULTING IN DEATH OF THE UNDERSIGNED ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE EVENT(S), WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted in RACING PROGRAMS, or to enter for any purposes the RESTRICTED AREAS (herein defined as including, but not limited to, the racing surface, pit areas, infield, burn-out area, approach area, shut-down area, and all walkways, concessions, and other appurtenant areas where any activity related to the Event(s) shall take place, or where special authorization, permission, or credentials are required, or where admittance to the general public is restricted or prohibited), or to compete, officiate, observe, work for, or participate in any way or for any other purpose in the Event(s), the Undersigned for himself/herself and for his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

1. ACKNOWLEDGES, agrees, and represents that the Undersigned has, or will immediately upon entering and continuously thereafter, inspected such Restricted Areas and does further warrant that the Undersigned's participation in the scheduled Event(s) and entrance upon the Restricted Areas, constitutes an acknowledgment that the Undersigned has inspected the Restricted Areas, and that it is safe and reasonably suited for the purposes of the RACING PROGRAM, and further agrees and warrants that if, at any time, the Undersigned is in or about Restricted Areas and feels anything to be unsafe, the Undersigned will immediately advise the Officials of such unsafe condition(s) and will leave the Restricted Areas.

2. HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES, AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations or any subdivision thereof, track operators, track owners, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, participants, any persons in the Restricted Areas, rescue personnel, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises on which the Event is conducted, premises inspectors, Event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants, and others who offer recommendations, directions, or instructions, or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or Event(s), and each of them, their officers, directors, agents, and employees, all for purposes herein referred to as "RELEASEES," from all liability to the Undersigned, the Undersigned's personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin FOR ALL LOSS OR DAMAGE SUSTAINED BY THE UNDERSIGNED, AND ANY CLAIM OR DEMANDS RESULTING THEREFROM, ON ACCOUNT OF INJURY TO THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OR RESULTING IN DEATH OF THE UNDERSIGNED, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, while the Undersigned is in or upon the Restricted Areas, and/or competing, officiating, observing, working for, or for any purpose participating in such Event.

3. HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the Undersigned in or upon the Restricted Areas, or in any way competing, officiating, observing, or working for, or for any purpose participating in the Event, and whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise; and

4. HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to negligence of Releasees or otherwise while in or upon the Restricted Areas, and/or while competing, officiating, observing, working for, or for any purpose participating in such Event(s);

5. EXPRESSLY acknowledges that the ACTIVITIES OF THE EVENT ARE VERY DANGEROUS and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. THE UNDERSIGNED also expressly acknowledges that INJURIES RECEIVED MAY BE COMPOUNDED OR INCREASED BY NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS OR PROCEDURES OF THE RELEASEES. THE UNDERSIGNED FURTHER UNDERSTANDS that: (a) the above referenced ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING VIRAL INFECTIONS, BACTERIAL INFECTIONS AND OTHER COMMUNICABLE DISEASES AND ILLNESSES, PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS, AND DEATH ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS AND SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me, or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.
