ESN 1 - CCES Pandemic Rules in effect.

ESN 2 - Headlights are required on the race cars per the BCCR. All lights: brake lights, tail lights, and head lights must be installed and operating by 6:00pm.

ESN 3 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR. Put a muffler on the race car.

ESN 4 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

Event Guidelines

Event Guidelines

- The following policies are subject to change based on local government guidelines in relation to COVID-19.
- All published local guidelines will be on hand for easy reference.
- ChampCar asks that anyone who is at higher risk for severe illness, feeling unwell, or who has been in contact with anyone that is sick in the last two weeks would stay home.
- If you are healthy, but uncomfortable being around other people for fear of illness, it may be better if you skip the event. ChampCar will happily move your fee to another event later in the year.
- Event is closed to spectators and visitors. All crew and drivers must be full ChampCar Members. All members of your team MUST be listed in registration 48-hours before Move-in Friday.
- While ChampCar is not limiting the number of team members per car in attendance, each track may have restrictions that we must follow. Please read the supplemental rules for each event to see if such restrictions exist.
- ChampCar recommends all participants follow current CDC guidelines on social distancing and personal protective gear. Signs will be placed around the venue to remind people of social distancing and protective health protocols. Teams are responsible for determining which types of protective gear (mask, gloves, etc.) they choose to use and for bringing sufficient supplies for themselves.
- ChampCar will work with the track to have frequently touched surfaces such as tables, counters, doorknobs, light switches, etc. cleaned with disinfectant at regular intervals.
- ChampCar will ensure there are plenty of hand washing stations and/or hand sanitizers in and around the facility, particularly high traffic areas.
- Only essential workers are allowed in specialty work areas such as timing & scoring and race control.

Tech Guidelines

- Only one team member (preferably the captain) may bring the car to tech.
- Tech paperwork is now done via the web. An electronic log-book will be issued. Car captains will need to visit the teams membership page to fill out your e-logbook. <https://champcar.org/register/login.php>
- Required decals will be available and set out on a table so you can pick up your own.
- We ask that you maintain six feet of distance from our tech inspectors.
- ChampCar will place less cars into the tech bay than normal to help maintain greater distances between people.

Gear Tech Procedures

- Arrive at gear tech fully suited up in your driver gear, carrying your helmet.
- ChampCar will hand you a gear check decal for you to apply on your own helmet. Apply the decal on the lower left chin area of the helmet. Any other area may delay you leaving pit out during the race.

Registration

- Only the captain is permitted to be at registration.
- If possible, complete all payments before arriving to registration.
- Registration line will be marked to maintain social distancing.
- Bring the team's completed COVID-19 waivers with you (no waiver = no driver band).
- Bring completed tech sheet and/or log book with you.
- Hard surfaces will be disinfected throughout the day.

Drivers Meeting

- Drivers meetings will be prerecorded and show on the ChampCar YouTube channel. Questions will be fielded by emailing the event director before the event.

Pit Road

- Some events may limit the number of people on pit road. Read the supplemental event rules for info. Even with no restrictions, ChampCar advises teams to not load up their pit boxes with extra people.
- Drivers will still be checked for arm bands at pit out. Please have your band ready to display to our pit out worker.
- Drivers will still need to report to Black Flag at pit in for on-track driving infractions. A ChampCar staff member will write out the infraction and place it on your windshield for you to read.
- All fueling rules remain in place.

Award Ceremony

- Award will be handed out to the teams at the impound area.

Event Info

Waivers: Pre-print and hand to the gate guard at gate 40, there may be another waiver you sign at the gate.

Paddock: Paddock will be both Blue and Yellow garage areas. Teams without a garage will be out near turn 1 in the grass area west of the Blue garages. Garage areas are locked at 7:00pm Friday and will be unlocked at 5:00am Saturday.

Garages: Garages are available for \$100. Purchase these when you register for the event. Email the event director if you want a garage after you register. Garages include electric. Remember that the garages are separated into Yellow and Blue. Pay close attention to your emails for assignments. Remember that you either get a garage OR a trailer slot, but not both. Space is limited. Garage areas are locked up at 7:00pm FRIDAY EVENING. Infield access is open 24 hours.

Paddock Electric: One space per team. No electric. Limited lighting. Paddock closes and is locked up at 7:00pm ON FRIDAY EVENING.

Pitlane Electric: Electrical hookups are limited along pitlane.

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/ paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Raceday Club Membership: \$20 at Gate 40. Children under 16 are free with parent or guardian.

Pets: Pets are allowed into the DIS facility must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

Camping: Available at Lake Lloyd Shores. Included with your \$75 camping fee. No reservations. First come, first parked.

Camping / Camper Hookups: Lake Loyd area has hookups. Paddock area does not have hookups. No reservations. First come, first parked. Pumpouts are \$50 cash. The number for the RV pump outs is #904-304-0766. The plan is to have the truck come thru the infield Friday and Saturday at 7pm but they must be present at their motorhome to flag down the driver.

Barbecues: NO Large Groups. Try to keep the socializing to your immediate social group. BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: During the times that the paddock is open, only the garage restrooms will be open. Once the paddock is closed down, the #6 restroom will be opened for overnight use. The Shower Houses will be closed all weekend due to COVID restrictions.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Will be open during normal hours.

Fuel on site: Not available onsite. Fuel is available at various stations outside of the track. Used oil and petroleum waste dump is located near the Daytona fuel pumps.

Weather: Cloud to cloud, and cloud to ground lightning within 10 miles will start a process of bringing all of the cars into the pitlane. The race will be red flagged. Get the drivers out of the cars, and all crew and drivers must exit pitlane and get to cover. DO NOT use your easy up as cover. The garages or your trailer are the best areas for cover.

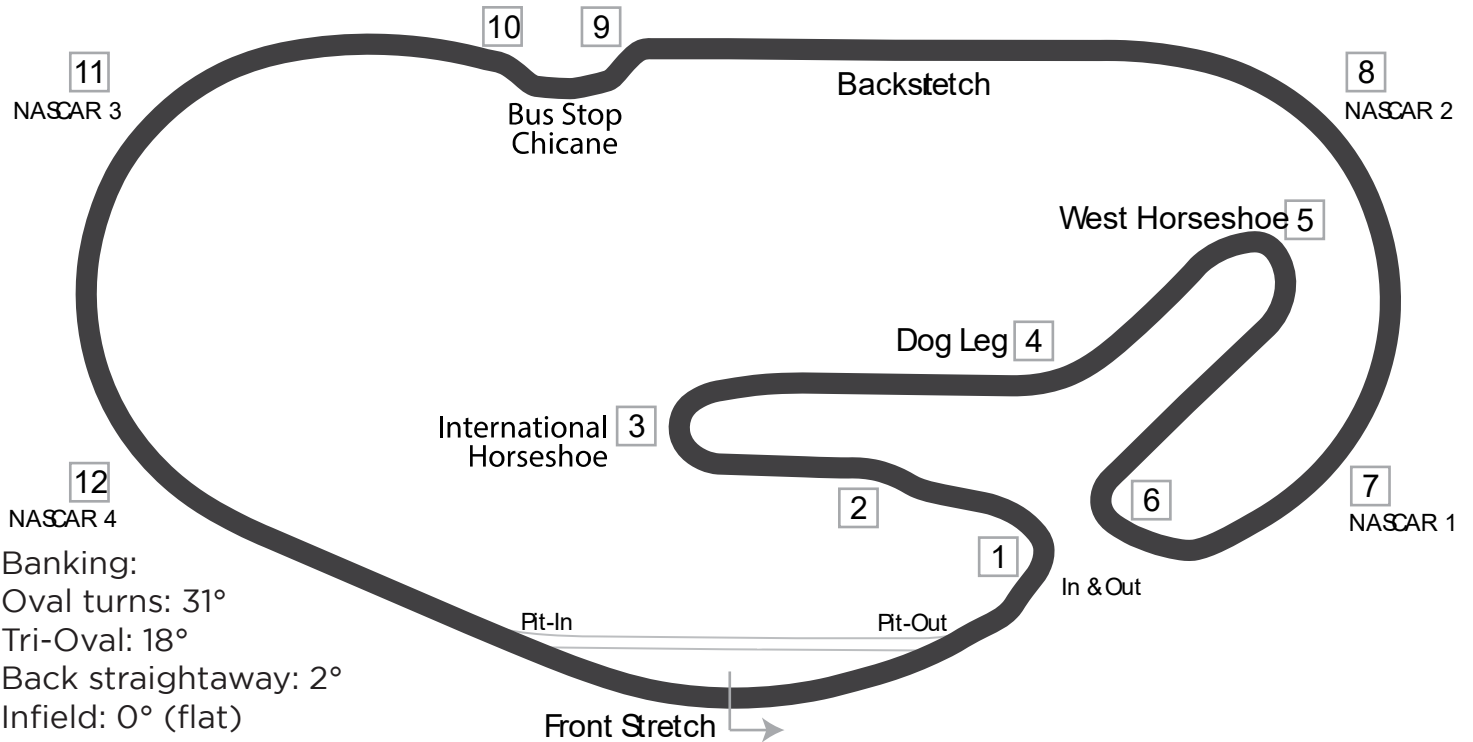

 Infield: 0° (flat)

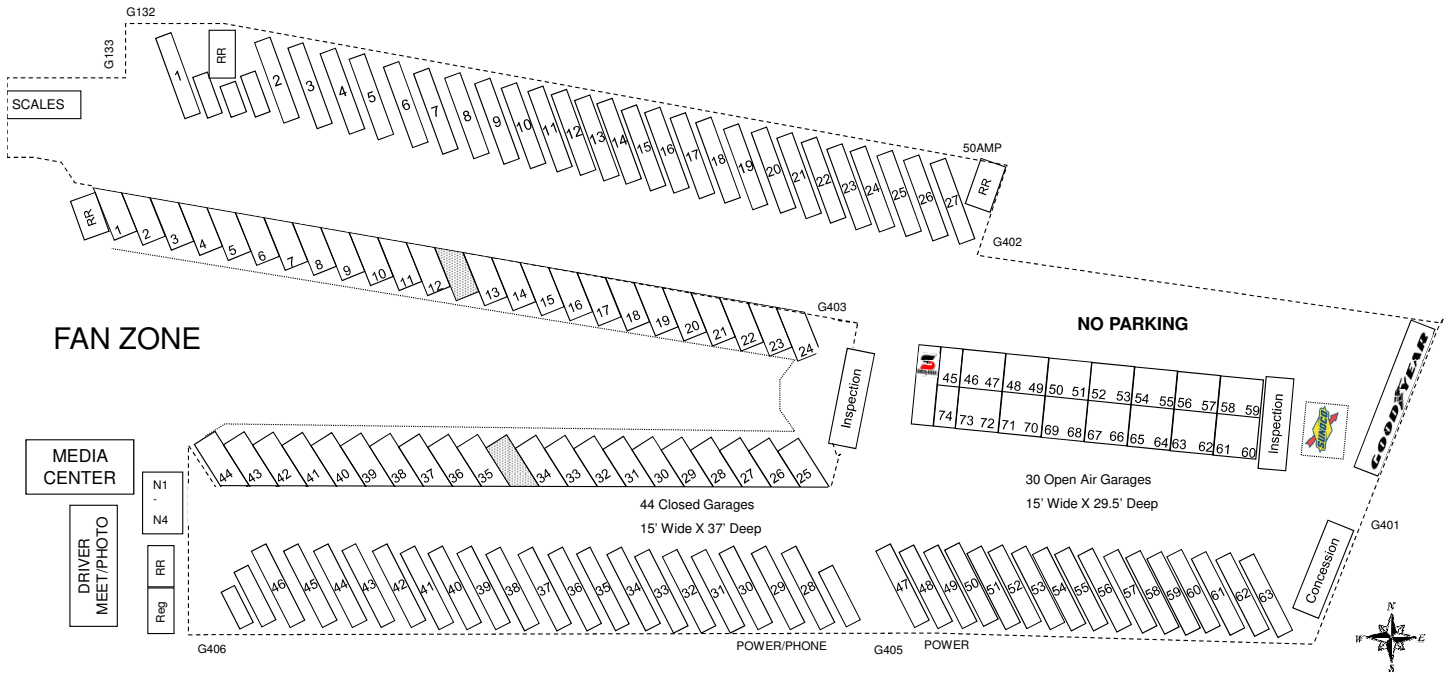




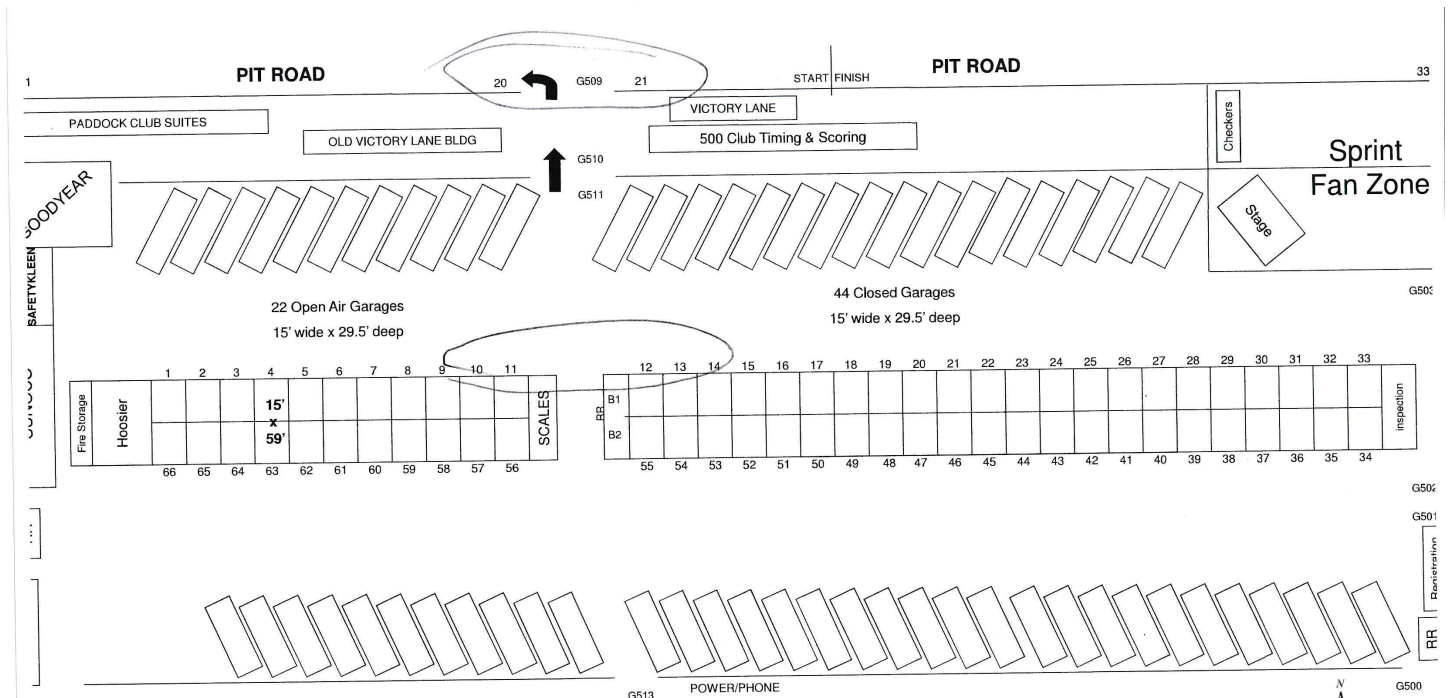

Garage assignments will be sent out to the team captains one week prior to the event.

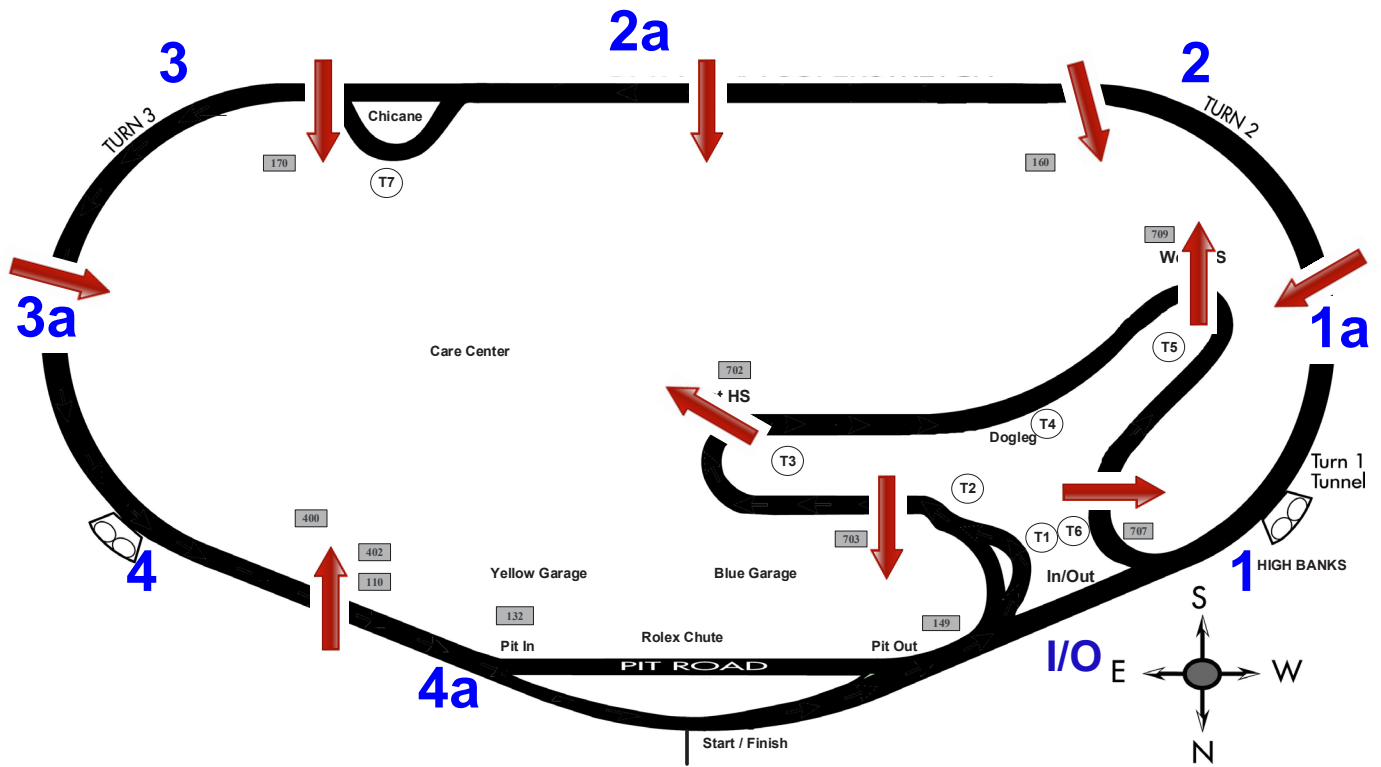


YELLOW GARAGE LAYOUT
