### Special Updates:

1. No one under 18 years of age is allowed onto WGI Property.
2. All participants will be required to show a state-issued ID to gain the facility entry armband.
3. Appropriate PPE/Face coverings will be required at all times while on WGI property. WGI/ChampCar will stop the event if participants are not wearing proper PPE.
4. Weekend memberships will not be allowed. All drivers and crew must be entered into the registration system for this event before midnight, May 25, 2021. No exceptions. The name entered into the registration system must match your state-issued ID. If your name is not on the registration list that we will give WGI, you will not be allowed into the facility. No exceptions.
5. Camping will be allowed.

### EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR. Mufflers required.

ESN 2 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 3 - Event Sponsor Decal installation instructions - Required Sahlen's Decal - provided free. Locate above Class letter on both sides. See decal sheet on last page of supps.

## *Pandemic Info*

### **Event Guidelines**

- The following policies are subject to change based on local government guidelines in relation to COVID-19.
- All published local guidelines will be on hand for easy reference.
- ChampCar asks that anyone who is at higher risk for severe illness, feeling unwell, or who has been in contact with anyone that is sick in the last two weeks would stay home.
- If you are healthy, but uncomfortable being around other people for fear of illness, it may be better if you skip the event. ChampCar will happily move your fee to another event later in the year.
- Event is closed to spectators and visitors. All crew and drivers must be full ChampCar Members. All members of your team MUST be listed in registration 48-hours before Move-in Friday.
- While ChampCar is not limiting the number of team members per car in attendance, each track may have restrictions that we must follow. Please read the supplemental rules for each event to see if such restrictions exist.
- ChampCar recommends all participants follow current CDC guidelines on social distancing and personal protective gear. Signs will be placed around the venue to remind people of social distancing and protective health protocols. Teams are responsible for determining which types of protective gear (mask, gloves, etc.) they choose to use and for bringing sufficient supplies for themselves.
- ChampCar will work with the track to have frequently touched surfaces such as tables, counters, doorknobs, light switches, etc. cleaned with disinfectant at regular intervals.
- ChampCar will ensure there are plenty of hand washing stations and/or hand sanitizers in and around the facility, particularly high traffic areas.
- Only essential workers are allowed in specialty work areas such as timing & scoring and race control.

### **Tech Guidelines**

- Only one team member (preferably the captain) may bring the car to tech.
- Tech paperwork is now done via the web. An electronic log-book will be issued. Car captains will need to visit the teams membership page to fill out your e-logbook. <https://champcar.org/register/login.php>
- Required decals will be available and set out on a table so you can pick up your own.
- We ask that you maintain six feet of distance from our tech inspectors.
- ChampCar will place less cars into the tech bay than normal to help maintain greater distances between people.

### **Gear Tech Procedures**

- Arrive at gear tech fully suited up in your driver gear, carrying your helmet.
- ChampCar will hand you a gear check decal for you to apply on your own helmet. Apply the decal on the lower left chin area of the helmet. Any other area may delay you leaving pit out during the race.

### **Registration**

- Only the captain is permitted to be at registration.
- If possible, complete all payments before arriving to registration.
- Registration line will be marked to maintain social distancing.
- Bring the team's completed COVID-19 waivers with you (no waiver = no driver band).
- Bring completed tech sheet and/or log book with you.
- Hard surfaces will be disinfected throughout the day.

### **Drivers Meeting**

- Drivers meetings will be prerecorded and show on the ChampCar YouTube channel. Questions will be fielded by emailing the event director before the event.

### **Pit Road**

- Some events may limit the number of people on pit road. Read the supplemental event rules for info. Even with no restrictions, ChampCar advises teams to not load up their pit boxes with extra people.
- Drivers will still be checked for arm bands at pit out. Please have your band ready to display to our pit out worker.
- Drivers will still need to report to Black Flag at pit in for on-track driving infractions. A ChampCar staff member will write out the infraction and place it on your windshield for you to read.
- All fueling rules remain in place.

### **Award Ceremony**

- Award will be handed out to the teams at the impound area.



# Event Supplementals

## Event Info

**Arrival Procedures:** All drivers and crew must be entered into the registration system for this event before midnight, **May 25, 2021**. No exceptions. The name entered into the registration system must match your state-issued ID. If your name is not on the registration list that we will give WGI, you will not be allowed into the facility.  
**No exceptions.**

Friday - Teams will be required to first park in Lot 3 and walk to the registration building by gate 4A. Registration building will be open from 7:00am - 6:00pm on Friday.

Do not pull trailers into the registration parking lot.

Bring your state issued ID card. This will be required to enter the facility.

In the registration office teams will sign the waiver, show your state issued ID card, and get a wristband that lets them enter the facility. With their wristband on, they will drive their truck and trailer back down CR16 and enter at Gate 2.

Security at Gate 2 will verify you have their wristband and let them enter the paddock.

Late arrivals on Friday will need to camp in Lot 3. You will be able to sign and get a ChampCar issued wrist band at 7:00am on Saturday. WGI will not allow anyone in without a ChampCar issued wristband. Driver / Crew bands will NOT work at the front gate.

**Test & Tune Information:** ChampCar is hosting the Test-Practice session on Friday that is included with your entry fee. Specific schedules for the Test - Practice will be released later. Remember that you must get your car through Tech and Registration during the day, make time for it during your running.

**Garages:** Garages are available for \$100. Purchase these when you register for the event. Email the event director if you want a garage after you register. Garages include electric.

**Paddock:** Limited lighting.

**Paddock Electric:** Limited power in the paddocks. You must pay WGI Security personnel, they will then unlock the power pole. These are located around the outside edge of the paddock.

**Pitlane Gates:** Plan for the pitlane to close soon after practice and the races have ended. Take whatever you need to work on your car in the paddock with you once the race ends. Pitlane gates are closed and locked by security

**Pitlane Electric:** Electric is available along pit lane, but cannot be guaranteed to work. Plan for it not to work.

**Lighting:** The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

**Pit Passes:** Not available for this event.

**Guest Pass:** Not available for this event.

**Pets:** Pets allowed into the track must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

**Children:** No children under 18 years of age are allowed on the Watkins Glen International facility for the 2021 event weekend.

**Camping:** Self-contained RV camping is allowed Friday & Saturday night in your paddock.

**Camping / Camper Hookups:** If you want one of the 25 RV sites with hookups you must book it separately. \$50 Hookup fee to WGI Security.

**Barbecues:** BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

**Restroom / Showers:** Yes / Yes - Located Near Camping Area on Richardson Road.

**Gate:** 24-hour gate coverage. Must have ChampCar WGI Wristband. No admission without it.

**Concessions:** Open Saturday and Sunday.

**Fuel on site:** Unleaded 93 Octane fuel is available for purchase at the WGI Fuel Pumps located near the track garages. There are local gas stations in town. They may close early in town, so plan accordingly.

**Weather:** We're racing, regardless of the weather.
