COVID-19: Only ChampCar Members (Regular or weekend only) will be admitted to the CTMP premises. Masks must be worn indoors. Please respect social distancing.

Quiet Hours: Observe QUIET HOURS from 11:00 pm to 8:00 am. Please turn off all music and generators during this time.

Paddock Electric: Very limited. Electric fee is \$20. Pay at the Restaurant.

Pitlane Electric: None

Lighting: There is no lighting in the paddock. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Pit Passes: Teams are advised that all team members, family, and guests who desire CTMP premises access MUST purchase a Weekend Membership Pass through ChampCar at the track. ChampCar members can obtain a free pit pass by showing their membership card.

Pets: Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and you must clean up after them. Pets are not allowed on pit road.

Children: Children under 16 are not allowed on pit road. Children must be under adult supervision at all times.

Camping: Self-contained camping is allowed in the paddock.

Camping / Camper Hookups: None

Barbecues: No open flame campfires or barbecues. Only gas grills used for cooking are allowed in the paddock.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. See map.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage starting on Friday.

Concessions: Trackside Grill - 7:30am-4:00pm
Opening hours dependent on how busy they are.

Fuel on site: Yes. Pumps will be open and prices are in Canadian Dollar

Sunoco 98 – 4.94 per litre
Ultra 94 – 1.89 per litre

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

Drones: Unmanned aircraft systems and drones are prohibited at ChampCar Endurance events at all times.

Pit Lane Assignments: First come, first served.

Medical: For First Aid assistance, please call our Fan Assistance Line at (905) 806-8419, or contact a ChampCar marshal or official. For a serious emergency, please call 911.

Smoking: No Smoking, No Cannabis Smoking or Vaping in restricted areas.

Drive carefully and watch out for children. Speed limit is 15km/h in camping areas, 10 km/h in the Paddock. Stay ON established roads and OFF the sand hills. Use of off-road vehicles and motorcycles is NOT permitted in the camping areas, but is permitted only in the Paddock and only for race-related business by licensed drivers aged 16 or older. Keep all vehicles off the race track. No Skateboards. No Rollerblading. No Scooters. No Fireworks.
