EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR. **Mufflers are required at WGI.**

ESN 2 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 3 - Event Sponsor Decal installation instructions - Apply Sahlen's decal to side door above class letter. Available at Tech.

ESN 4 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

Technical Information

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:

This information is subject to change.

Required starting June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent for free at registration.

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Lights: Lights for this event are not required, but should be available in case of inclement weather racing.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft. Sound measuring is drivers left.

Venue Specific Information

Arrival Procedures: Friday - Teams will be required to first park in Lot 3 and walk into the registration building by gate 4A . Registration building will be open from 7:00am - 6:00pm on Friday. Do not pull trailers into the registration parking lot.

In the registration office teams will sign the waiver and get a wristband that lets them enter the facility.

With their wristband on, they will drive their truck and trailer back down CR16 and enter at Gate 2.

Security at gate 2 will verify they have their wristband and let them enter the paddock.

Late arrivals on Friday will need to camp in Lot 3. You will be able to sign and get a ChampCar issued wrist band at 7:00am on Saturday. WGI will not allow anyone in without a ChampCar issued wristband. Driver / Crew bands will NOT work.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

Test & Tune: ChampCar is hosting the Test-Practice session on Friday that is included with your entry fee. Specific schedules for the Test - Practice will be released later. Remember that you must get your car through Tech and Registration during the day, make time for it during your running.

Track Access: No one is allowed access to the track after operations hours for any reason, i.e., running, walking, etc.

Waiver and Wristbands: Only the team captain needs to check in at registration to receive driver and crew credentials. More information will be available as we get closer to the event.

Garages: Garages are available for \$100. Purchase these when you register for the event. Email the event director if you want a garage after you register. Garages include electric. Do not store fuel in the garage. Garage wifi password is " WgiRacing ".

Paddock: Limited power in the paddocks. See map. You must pay WGI Security personnel, they will then unlock the power pole. These are located around the outside edge of the paddock.

Pitlane Access: The pitlane area gate is locked at the conclusion of the days race event. Please plan accordingly.

Pitlane Electric: Electrical hookups are limited along pitlane.

Lighting: The paddock has minimal area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Venue Specific Information

WGI premises are subject to video surveillance.

Pets: Pets allowed into the track must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

Children: No children 18 or under on the cold or hot side of pit lane. Remember, this is New York. They have some very strict rules about age restrictions for minors, these are state laws, not just track rules.

Camping / RV Hookups: Self-contained RV camping is allowed Friday & Saturday night in your paddock. If you want one of the 25 RV sites with hookups you must book it separately. \$50 Hookup fee to WGI Security.

Barbecues: NO Large Groups. Try to keep the socializing to your immediate social group. BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes / Yes - Located Near Camping Area on Richardson Road.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage. Must have ChampCar WGI Wristband. No admission without it.

Concessions: Open Saturday and Sunday.

Fuel on site: Unleaded 93 Octane fuel is available for purchase at the WGI Fuel Pumps located near the track garages. There are local gas stations in town. They may close early in town, so plan accordingly.
Used oil and petroleum waste dump is located in the garage paddock.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

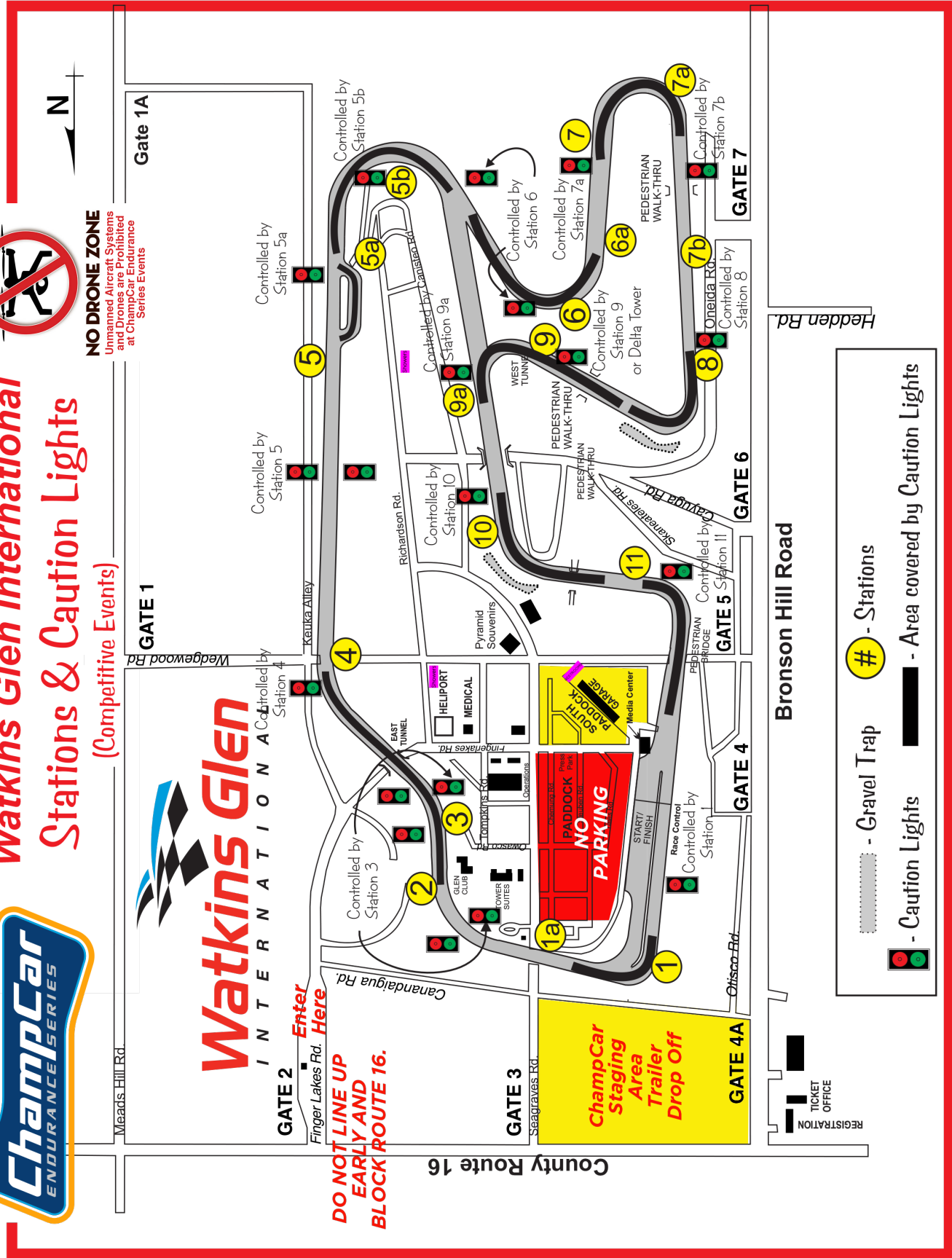

 - Area covered by Caution Lights



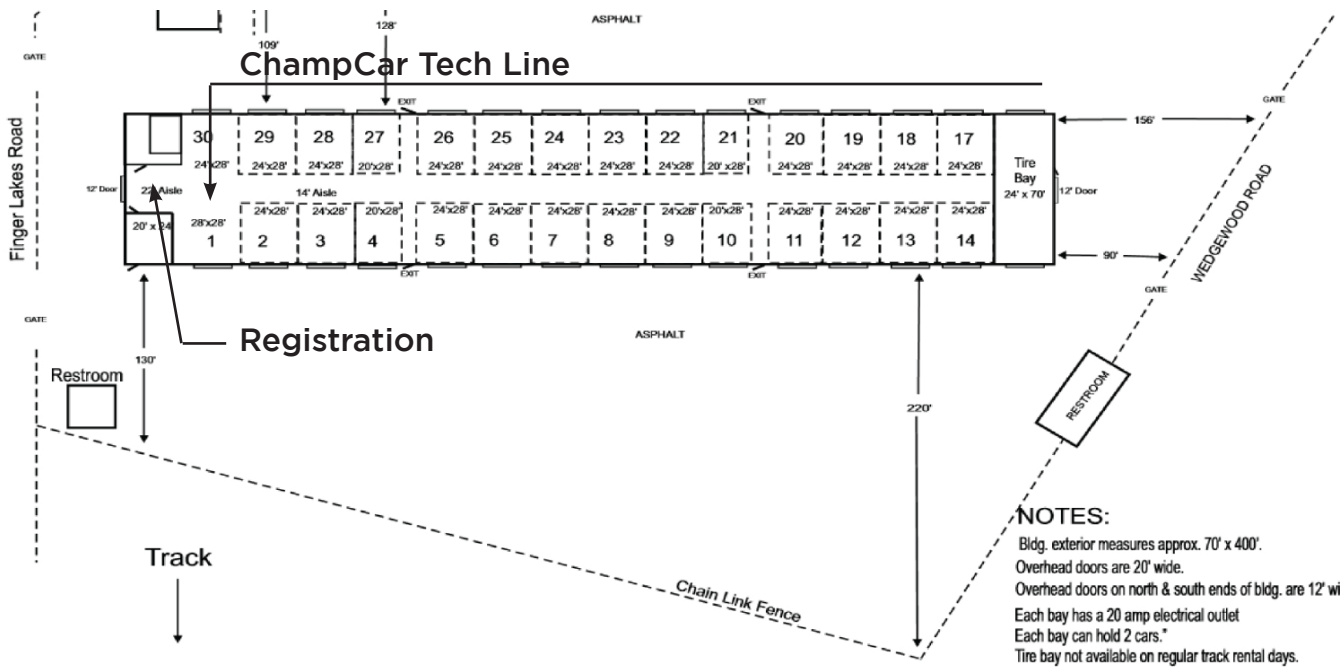

 - Overhead doors on north & south ends of bldg. are 12' wide.
 - Each bay has a 20 amp electrical outlet
 - Each bay can hold 2 cars.*
 - Tire bay not available on regular track rental days.
