Event Info

Technical Information

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form. The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:
This information is subject to change.

Required June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. The system will be working at this event. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent.

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Track Damage Fees:

Oil Dry - \$20/bag (Based on actual usage)
Damaged Guardrail replacement - \$1,000.00 per section
Damaged concrete barrier replacement - \$1,000.00 per section
Damaged tire wall bundle replacement - \$500.00 per bundle
Damaged debris fencing replacement - \$1,000.00 per section
Damaged conveyer belting replacement - \$100.00 per foot
Damaged catch fence post replacement - \$100.00 per post
Fire incident - \$300.00 per fire bottle
Damaged tow strap - \$50.00 per tow strap

Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course Minor Policy:

Anyone under the age of 18 must submit a minor waiver to Mid-Ohio's Chief Registrar ten (10) days prior to the event. All parents/guardians of minors need to contact Mid-Ohio at 419.884.4000 ext 3007.

Absolutely no minors under the age of 15-years of age can participate in on track activities.

You also will need to get the ChampCar minor waivers from the event director, Chelsey Vickery.

Venue Specific Information

Thursday Mid-Ohio Test & Tune Information: Get some track time at Mid-Ohio in your competition car. Open to licensed racers and car club competitors. Cars are typically divided into 3 groups: closed wheel (small bore), closed wheel (large bore), and open wheel. Registration begins at 7:30 am for full day and 3:30 pm for twilight sessions, followed by a mandatory drivers meeting. Track time is from approximately 8:45 am to 4:30 pm for full day sessions and from approximately 5:00 pm to dusk for twilight sessions. Must provide your own race car and helmet. Must be 18 years of age or have permission from School Director to participate. Trailer Drop Off: The Mid Ohio School will be doing a Test and Tune starting at 5:00pm-8:00pm. Registration for the Test and Tune will start at 3:30pm at The School Booth located in the lower paddock by the concession stand. Competitors can sign up online. ChampCar trailer drops can be done from 5:30pm-7:30pm. Please note the Test and Tune customers will be in the Middle Paddock.

Paddock Electric: None

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/ paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Event Info

Garages: Garages are for rent. \$100. Pay at time of event registration.

Quiet Hours: Quiet hours will be enforced from 10pm-6am.

Paddock: Speed limit is restricted to 20 mph in all areas of the facility.

Weekend Membership Passes: Cannot go over the wall, \$20 for the weekend at registration. Over the wall crew must be full ChampCar club members.

Venue Specific Information

Pets: While Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course does not encourage bringing pets to the track, we do allow them. Pets are the responsibility of the pet owner. Pet owners are liable for any injury or damage caused by their pets. All pets must be kept under the control of a leash no longer than 6 ft. Please be courteous and clean up after your pet. Failure to do so will result in removal from the event. Pets are not permitted in any buildings, concession areas, grandstands or viewing mounds, hospitality locations, paddock/garage areas, false grid, or pit lane. Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course reserves the right to restrict/remove disruptive or exotic pets. If your pet disrupts or causes harm to another individual or property, you and your pet may be removed from the facility without a refund.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

Camping / Camper Hookups: \$25 RV Parking Pass Paid at the Gate. Overnight camping is allowed in the Lower and Middle Paddock areas. 24-hour access is available from load-in Friday morning until departure Sunday afternoon. There are no water hookups and a limited number of power outlets. We recommend that trailer / RV type units be self-sufficient with both water and generator power supply. Access is first-come first-choice. For those of you renting a camper. Mid Ohio will not accept delivery of campers on behalf of customers. This means you must be present to take delivery of your RV. Please arrange delivery of your camper / RV so you will be onsite to receive it. Camper / RV units cannot be delivered on Thursday.

Barbecues: Paddock and camping areas only. Not allowed on pit road. BBQ's are allowed in the camping and paddock parking area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Yes. Concessions is open during business hours. Friday: 10am-2pm. Sat-Sun - Open Hours may vary.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

Shipping items: Packages shipped to the track should be shipped UPS/FedEx with name and cell number to 7721 Steam Corners Road, Lexington, OH, 44904. If sent through USPS, use PO Box 3108. USPS does not deliver to the track. Mail is picked up at the post office by our staff Monday - Friday and could be delayed during race weekends. Larger items might get held at the post office counter or returned.
