Technical Information

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams at Road Atlanta will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Speedwaiver: TBD.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:
This information is subject to change.

Required June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. The system will be working at this event. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent.

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Venue Specific Information

Paddock: Paddock parking will be directed by staff. Large haulers will be positioned on a separate pad to allow for space.

Paddock Electric: None. Bring generators.

Pitlane Electric: None. Bring generators.

Lighting: None. Bring lighting and power for night work. No track lighting will be used.

Weekend Memberships: Available at registration for \$20.

Pets: They are welcome on property, but must be kept on a leash. You must clean up after your pets.

Children: No children under-16 allowed on pit road. No bicycles allowed in the paddock area.

Camping: Fully self-contained camping is allowed in the camping area. Teams may camp in their haulers if they are equipped, however only a single hauler will be allowed in the paddock area. Secondary campers, motorhomes, etc must be parked in the camping area by the main gate.

Camping / Camper Hookups: There are 10 camp sites with electric hookups available. These sites must be booked ahead of time directly through the track. Contact Palm Beach International Raceway for more information.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / No. Restrooms are portable units. There are no showers on site.

Venue Specific Information

Water: There is no access to potable water (drinking water) on site. Please bring plenty of drinking water for your team.

Gate: 24 hour access to camping and paddock area, after hour access to paddock area requires event wrist band.

Concessions: Open Saturday and Sunday.

Fuel on site: There are gas pumps on site, however they are not owned or run by the track and credit card performance is sometimes questionable. Fuel onsite is 93, 110 and up. A Shell station is approximately 2-miles east on the main road.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

Pit carts, golf carts, mini bikes etc: Only persons with a driver's license may operate any motorized or powered vehicle.

One more special note: PBIR does not allow any glass bottles on PBIR property.
