EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Teams may add up to 10% antifreeze to their radiators for this event.

ESN 2 - Headlights are required on the race cars per the 2023 BCCR. Lights may be required to be turned on during inclement weather.

ESN 3 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

ESN 4 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 5 - Event Sponsor Decal installation instructions - None

ESN 6 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 7 - The required Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display will be available rent. \$50 at registration. Transponders are also available to rent at registration for \$50.

Technical Information

Driver & Crew: Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband and helmet decal from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form. The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration. Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:
This information is subject to change.
Required starting June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. Limited quantities available at registration. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Lights: Headlights and running lights turned on at 5:00pm. Subject to change.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

Test & Tune Information: None.

Paddock: ChampCar will be using the VIR South Paddock.

Paddock Electric: Very limited, and it has not always worked in the past. Bring generators if power is needed. The paddock gets VERY dark.

Pitlane Electric: None. Bring generators.

Pit Lane Heaters: Heaters on pit lane are not allowed.

Lighting: The pit lane is not lit. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Venue Specific Information

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members. Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you spectator and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: They are welcome on property, but must be kept on a leash. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets and must dispose of their waste properly. Pets are not allowed in the cold pits.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road. Minors between 16-18 years old who are ChampCar members with a completed Minor Waiver and who are registered to participate can attend.

Camping: Self-contained RV camping is allowed Friday & Saturday night. Must be out by 11am Sunday.

Camping / Camper Hookups: There are no hookups, and only one or two power pole hookups. These get taken fast so bring a generator.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes. Restrooms are located on the ground floor of the South Paddock Tower. Showers are located in the North Paddock.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: North Course Concessions will operate from 7 am-5 pm Friday and Saturday. A food truck will be available 11 am - 8 pm on south course on Saturday.

Fuel on site: Credit card pumps available in the north paddock

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.

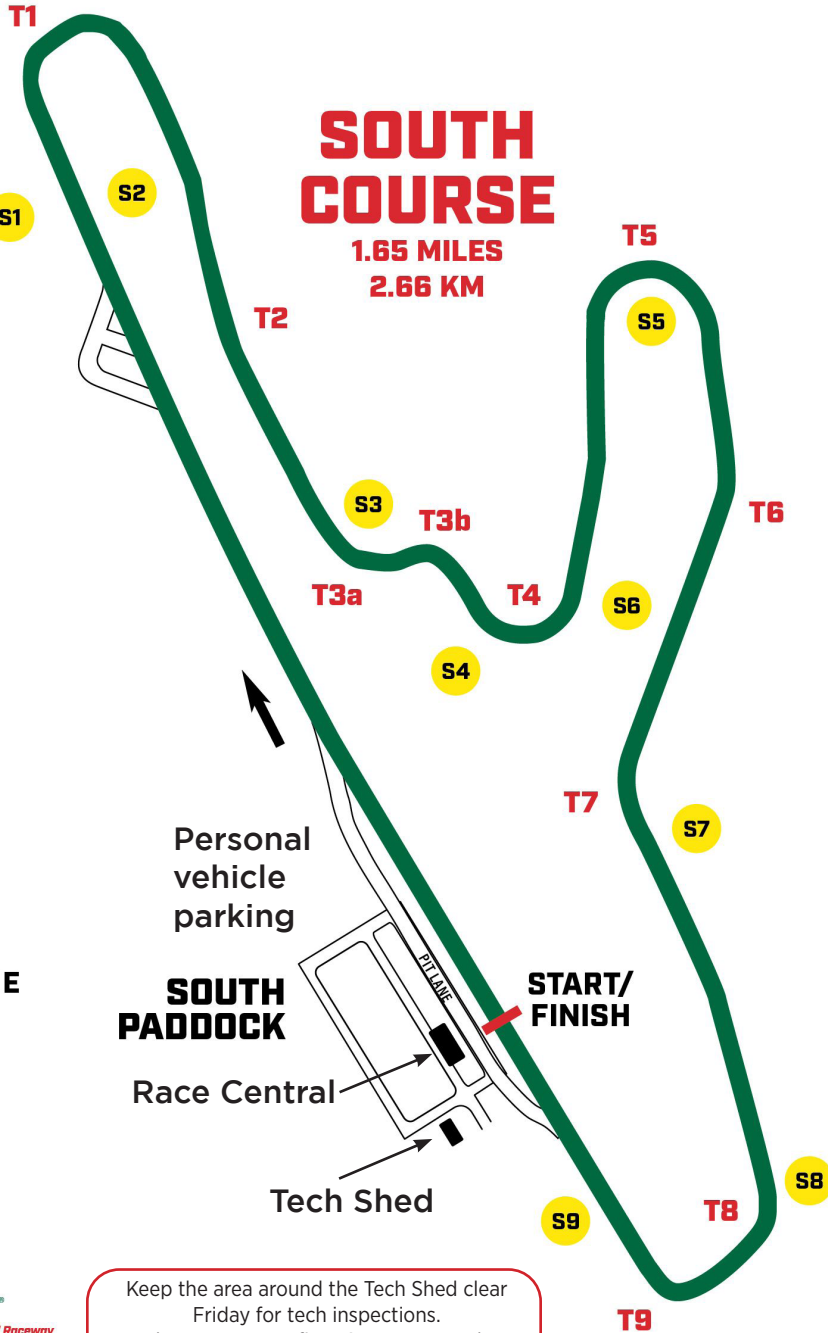
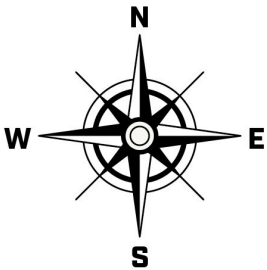
