EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR. Mufflers are required at NCM. Friday NCM Test Day teams will be notified if they are over the 96dbA limit.

ESN 2 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 3 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 4 - The required Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display will be available rent. \$50 at registration. Transponders are also available to rent at registration for \$50.

ESN 5 - Headlights are required on the race cars per the 2023 BCCR. Lights may be required to be turned on during inclement weather.

ESN 6 - Friday NCM Test Day is run by NCM under NCM control. This is a separate event from the ChampCar event. See page 2 for info.

Technical Information

Driver & Crew: Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband and helmet decal from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:
This information is subject to change.

Required starting June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. Limited quantities available at registration. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft. See next column for more details.

Venue Specific Information

Facility Update: We just wanted to update you on the conditions we will be working with at NCM due to the recent tornado.

There are many buildings that are fenced off that are awaiting demolition. These are NO GO ZONES. It has been made very clear that NO ONE is allowed to go in the fences /buildings. They will give you the boot off the property. No exceptions.

Pre-Registering at \$450 per team gets you and your team on track for the entire day. There will be day of registration for \$500. This open track day will serve as a test for the ChampCar Endurance Series. The format will be an open session with a lunch break in the middle.

A tech form will need to be filled out by the team captain, with any additional drivers needing a separate entry to receive a wristband. We reserve the right to deny track access to any driver during the event.

Sound Limits: The NCM Motorsports Park wants to respect our neighbors and protect their ability to enjoy their property. The Clark Circle neighborhood contains many sound sources both natural (birds, dogs, wind blowing through trees) and man-made (I-65, Beech Bend Raceway, aircraft overflights, lawnmowers, HVAC systems) that collectively contribute to the community sound levels. The relative effect of those sound sources on community sound levels is often a function of atmospheric conditions like wind speed and direction, temperature, relative humidity and the presence of temperature inversions.

The ChampCar BCCR limit is 96dbA at 50'. This will be strictly enforced. Mufflers will be required on all vehicles to pass.

Event Info

Quiet Hours: Quiet hours for the entire facility are from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. This includes all lodging and camping areas. NCM does ask that all guests be considerate of others and not play loud music. Any music that is determined to be a nuisance by Security must be turned down or off. No engines may be run before 8:00 a.m. or after 6:00 p.m. Un-muffled engines are prohibited.

Garages: 17 garages are currently available to rent for the weekend. Visit <https://www.motorsportspark.org/track-rental/#garage> to book now. First come, first served.

Paddock Electric: None

Pitlane Electric: None. Bring generators.

Pit Lane Heaters: Heaters on pit lane are not allowed.

Lighting: The pit lane is not lit. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for night time mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources.

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members. Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you spectator and cold pit lane access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: Pets allowed into the track must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road. Minors between 16-18 years old who are ChampCar members with a completed Minor Waiver and who are registered to participate can attend.

Camping: Self contained camping free.

Barbecues: No open campfires or barrel fires are allowed. Only contained, manufactured barbecues and grills are permitted.

Restroom / Showers: Yes / Yes

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage

Concessions: Food truck. Limited hours.

Fuel on site: Yes. The following fuel octanes are available for credit card purchase only: 87, 93, 100 Unleaded, 110 leaded, and diesel. 110 leaded is ethanol-free (for off-road and racing applications only).

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather.
