EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Lights are required on the race cars per the BCCR.

ESN 2 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

ESN 3 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 4 - The Paddock will be locked Friday at 7:00 PM. Everyone must be out of the paddocks and Garages.

ESN 5 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 6 - Flagtronics will be available for rent at \$50 per event weekend. Available at Race Central / Registration.

Technical Information

Driver & Crew: Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband and helmet decal from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:

This information is subject to change.

Required starting June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. Limited quantities available at registration. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Lights: Headlights and running lights turned on at 6:00pm.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

Venue Specific Information

Track Access: No one is allowed access to the track after operations hours for any reason, i.e., running, walking, etc.

Garages: Garages are available for \$100. Purchase these when you register for the event. Email the event director if you want a garage after you register. Garages include electric and your assigned trailer spot. Remember that the garages are separated into Yellow and Blue. Pay close attention to your emails for assignments. Space is limited. Parking location for personal vehicles will be added to the supps closer to the event.

Garage areas are locked up at 7:00pm FRIDAY EVENING. Infield access is open 24 hours.

Paddock: Paddock will be both Blue and Yellow garage areas. Teams without a garage will be parked east of the Yellow Garages, overflow trailer lot. See map on page 4, Trailer Parking Drop Off Area.

Garage areas are locked at 7:00pm Friday and will be unlocked at 5:00am Saturday.

No electric. Limited lighting. One space per team. Included with your race entry fee. At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.

Pitlane Electric: Electrical hookups are limited along pitlane.

Lighting: The pit lane has very limited lighting and minimal pit/paddock area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for fueling or mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

The Supplemental Rules May Be Updated Without Notice.

Teams Are Advised To Check Them With Regularity And Print A Copy For Reference Prior To Coming To The Event.

Venue Specific Information

Daytona premises are subject to video surveillance.

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members.

Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: Pets are allowed into the DIS facility must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Pet access is a privilege not a right. The track reserves the right to deny pet access to the property at any time.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road. Minors between 16-18 years old who are ChampCar members with a completed Minor Waiver and who are registered to participate can attend. Children must be under adult supervision at all times

Camping / RV Hookups: Available at Lake Lloyd Shores. Included with your \$75 camping fee. No reservations. First come, first parked. Lake Lloyd area has hookups. Paddock area does not have hookups. No reservations. First come, first parked. Pumpouts are \$50 cash. The number for the RV pump outs is #904-304-0766. The plan is to have the truck come thru the infield Friday and Saturday at 7pm but they must be present at their motorhome to flag down the driver.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Showers and bathrooms are opened.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage

Concessions: Will be open during normal hours.

Fuel on site: Not available onsite. Fuel is available at various stations outside of the track. Race fuel may be available at these stations.

Used oil and petroleum waste dump is located near the Daytona fuel pumps.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather. Cloud to cloud, and cloud to ground lightning within 10 miles will start a process of bringing all of the cars into the pitlane. The race will be red flagged. Get the drivers out of the cars, and all crew and drivers must exit pitlane and get to cover. DO NOT use your easy up as cover. The garages or your trailer are the best areas for cover.

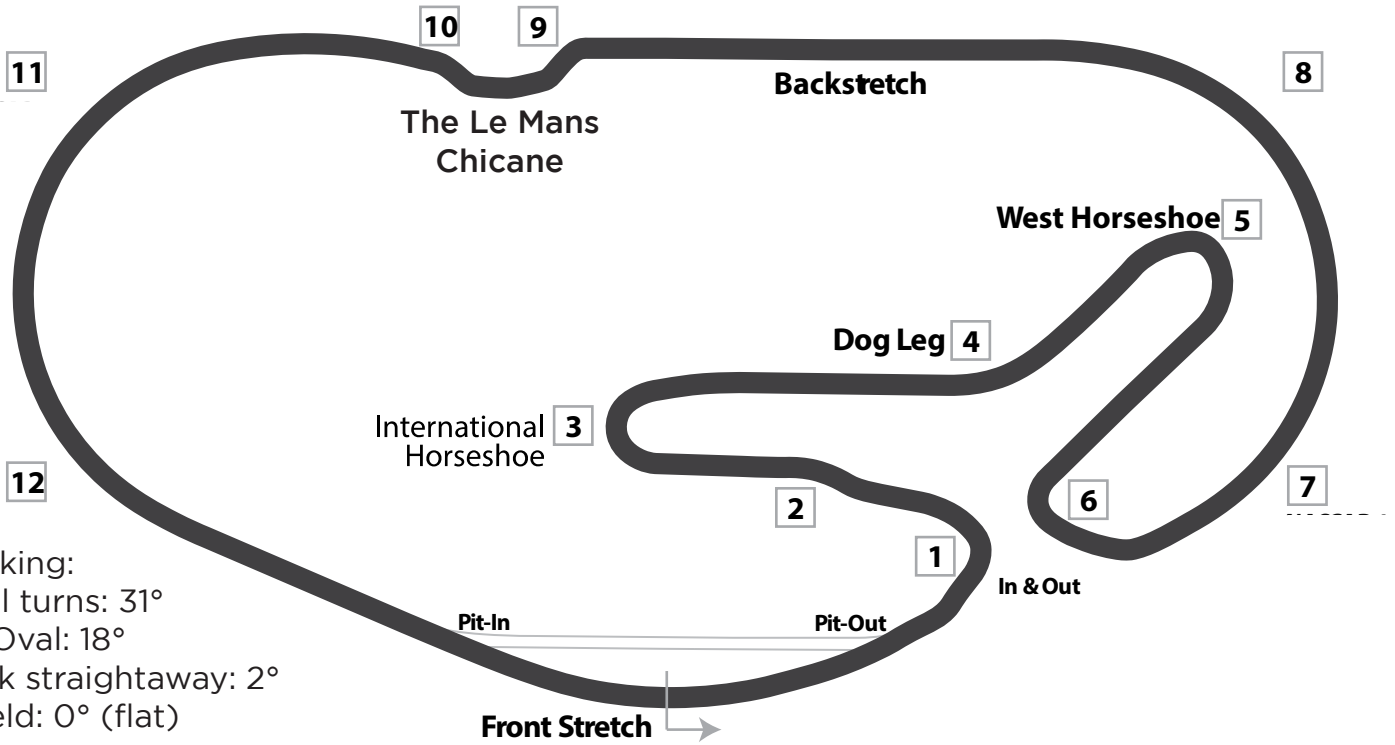

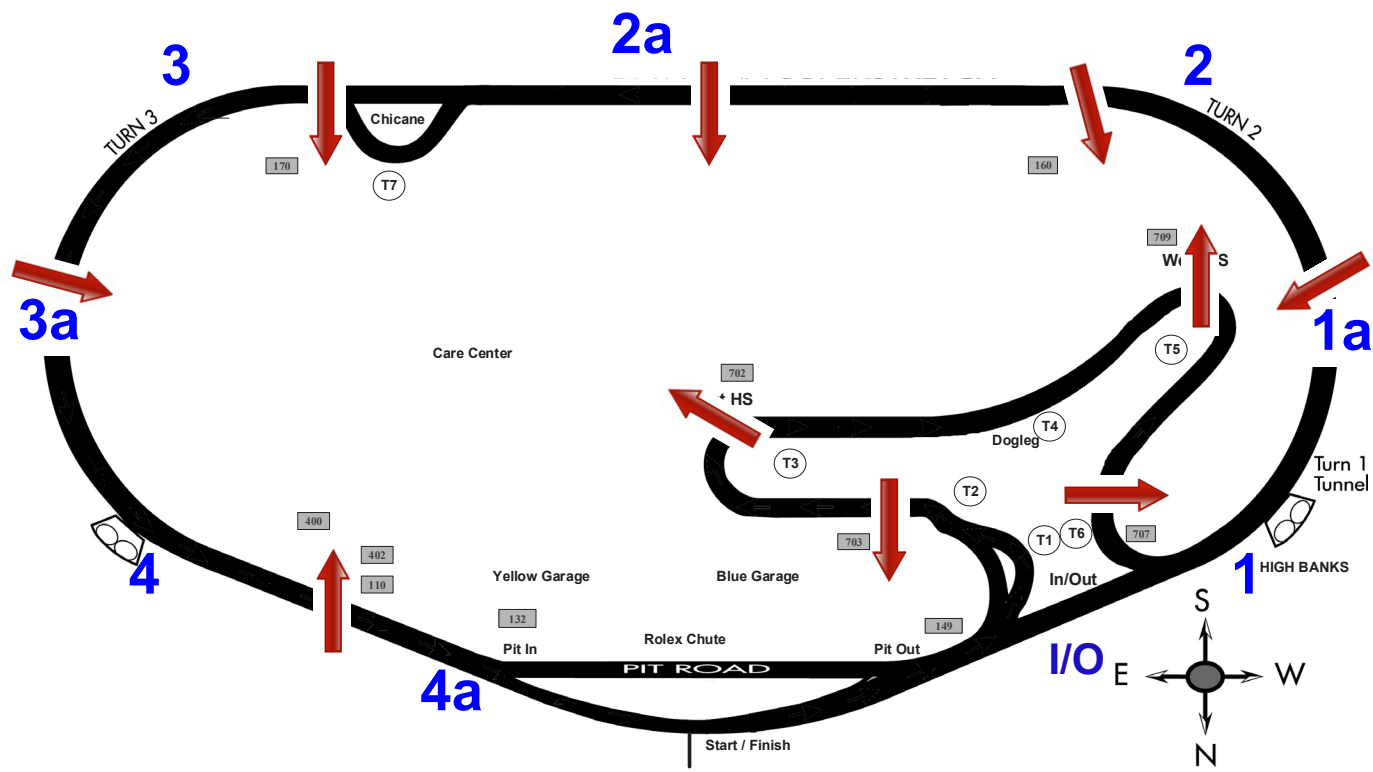

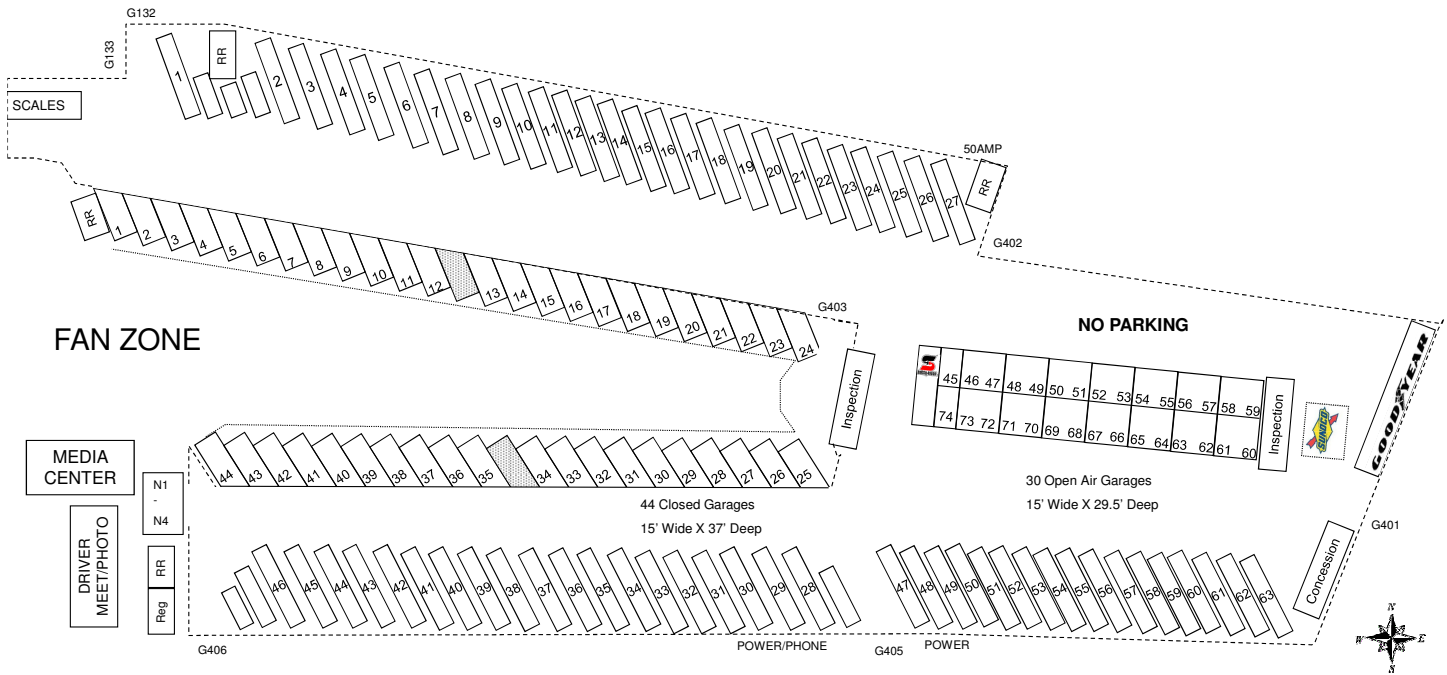

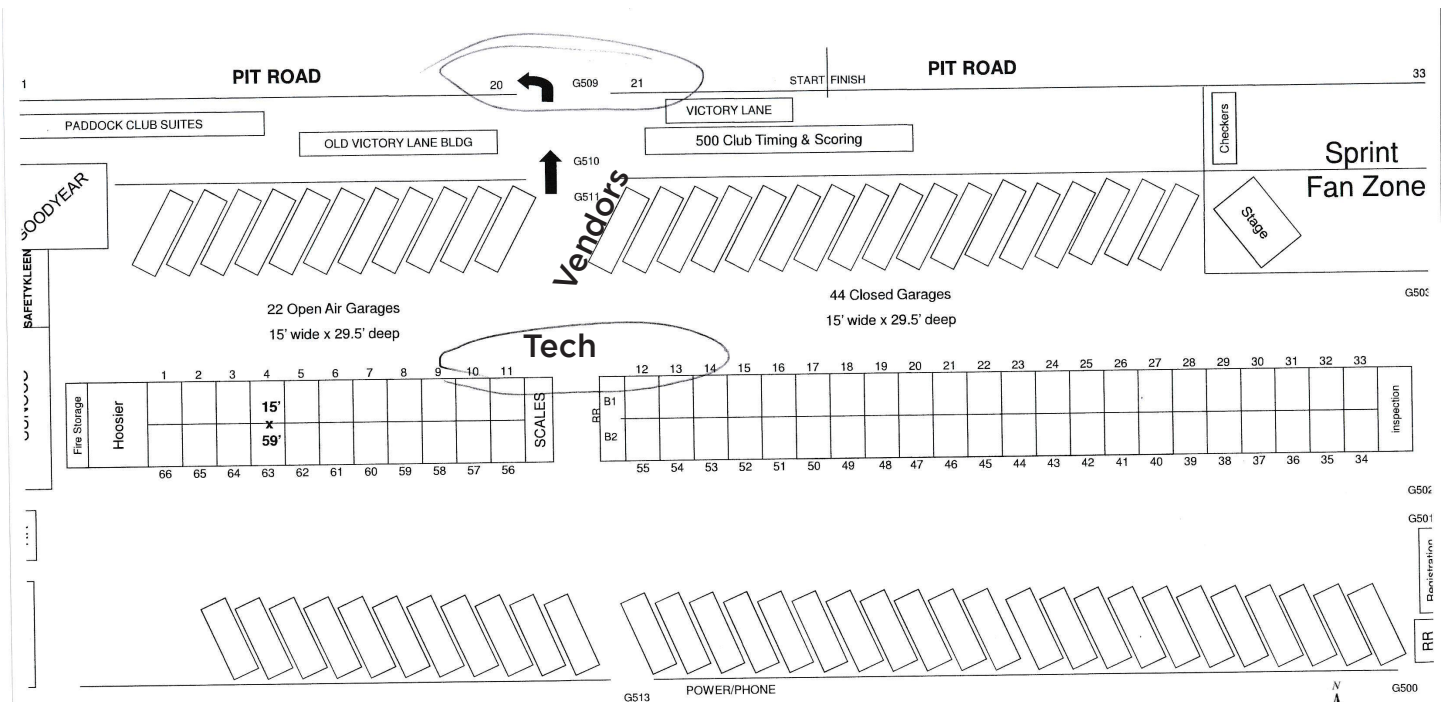
