ESN 1 - Lights are required on the race cars per the BCCR.

ESN 2 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

ESN 3 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 4 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

Technical Information

Driver & Crew: Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband and helmet decal from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:
This information is subject to change.

Required starting June 1, 2022 per the BCCR. Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. Limited quantities available at registration. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

Venue Specific Information

OIR = Ozarks International Raceway

Waivers: All persons entering Ozarks International Raceway ("OIR") property (the "Facility") are required to sign appropriate OIR and Sanctioning body Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement Forms. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS.

Minors: All minors must be under direct supervision of an adult at all times. No minor will be permitted to drive any motorized vehicle unsupervised on the property unless OIR is in possession of a professional racing license and properly executed waiver and consent. Contact Chelsey.vickery@champcar.org for minor waivers before the event.

Test & Tune Information: Free and highly recommended to all team drivers. New and very technical track. See schedule. Passengers are allowed as long as they have the same safety equipments as the driver. Full ChampCar race configurations are required. Full ChampCar driver/passenger gear are also required.

Track Access: No one is allowed access to the track after operations hours for any reason, i.e., running, walking, etc.

Pit Lane Rules: Speed limit 20MPH.

The pit entrance and pit exit lanes are considered part of the Track. Slow cones will be setup and explained at the drivers meeting. Drivers exiting the pit lane shall remain on drivers right and not cross the solid blend line on drivers left until line turns dashed. No minors on pit lane, excluding those minor racers with approved waivers. All road courses and pit lanes must be used only in the track direction.

Pit Lane Clothing - Long pants are required on the hot and cold pitlane. Closed toe shoes are required.

Pit/Paddock vehicles: The Speed Limit for all vehicles in any paddock area is 10 miles per hour. Fines will be levied against anyone who is deemed to be driving or riding any vehicle in an unsafe manner or at a speed considered by OIR to be in excess of the speed limit.

Track Maps

ATV's and Other Paddock Vehicles: The use of unlicensed vehicles such as mini-bikes, golf carts, scooters, and four wheelers shall be restricted to their use as a service vehicles for competitors and shall be used only in the paddock, on pit lane vehicle service area, on paved surfaces and only during event hours. Only licensed drivers/riders shall use such vehicles. Minors are specifically prohibited from using such vehicles in the paddock or on any of the general or public access areas. OIR reserves the right to further restrict the use of these vehicles if, in the sole discretion of OIR such use is a danger or annoyance to other persons.

Garages: : Garages are available for rent. They are \$100 for the weekend and can easily accommodate more than one car.
NO FUELING IN THE GARAGES. NO FUEL STORAGE IN GARAGE.

Paddock : No electric. Limited lighting. One space per team. Included with your race entry fee. Operators of all motor vehicles (including golf cars) must possess a valid state-issued driver's license. At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.

Each competitor must have at least one (1) portable dry chemical fire extinguisher with a rating of at least 12BC available and in good working condition in the competitor's pit and/or paddock area. Competitors must have fire extinguishers that are rated for use on the type of battery each electric vehicle is using.
No loud music or boom-boxes are permitted. Paddock quiet times must be respected (10:00 pm to 6:00 am).

Damage to Paved Surfaces: No holes or any other damage may be caused to any paved surfaces. Tents and canopies must be held down by weights as no tent pegs of any kind are allowed. Flat blocks or wood squares should be used to absorb weight beneath any equipment that may cause damage to the surface, such as trailer legs jack stands, kart stands, air jacks, and pump jacks.

Hazardous Waste Products: OIR will enforce strict compliance with rules relating to waste and hazardous materials, their containment and actions required to recover or repair surfaces affected by any spills.

At various locations in the paddocks, a number of collection facilities for used fluids and waste materials. Participants are required to make use of these for all waste materials and fluid disposal, using the appropriate receptacles (as identified on each drum).

Hazardous Material Control: Spills of damage causing fluids such as oils, hydraulic and brake fluids, gasoline, antifreeze, battery acid, ect., may occur and can cause significant damage to paved and grass surfaces and the environment as well as creating dangerous situations for track users and other participants. All spills must be treated immediately on occurrence. OIR management or ChampCar Staff must immediately be advised of all spills.

Trash and Waste Disposal: All trash shall be deposited in trash containers. Do not place any petroleum products in trash containers.

Fences: No climbing of fences.

Guest & Pit Passes: All people that go over the pit wall must be full ChampCar Club Members.
Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane.

Pets: Pets are not allowed on OIR properties.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road. Minors between 16-18 years old who are ChampCar members with a completed Minor Waiver and who are registered to participate can attend. Children must be under adult supervision at all times.

Camping: Self contained camping free.

Camping / Camper Hookups: When space is available, RV Parking is permitted in Paddock. RV Paddock parking must be reserved in advance. The Paddock will have restricted access between 10:00 pm and 6:00 am. RV Parking is also available in the designates RV Lot and must be reserved in advance. The RV lot will be sold on a first come first serve basis. Details TBD.

Barbecues: No open campfires or barrel fires are allowed. Only contained, manufactured barbeques and grills are permitted.

Restroom / Showers: Yes / NO - Kohler building near the Paddock Shop/Medical building. Due to the forecasted weather, the showers will not be available.

Use of Alcohol: All State, County, and other regulatory liquor laws and regulations will apply. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed in the pit or paddock areas until 60 minutes after the end of the final event or track activity of each day.

Substance Abuse: No use of controlled substances is permitted at Ozarks International Raceway. Anyone found using controlled substances illegally, or who appears to be impaired or under the influence of alcohol or drugs while using any of the OIR facilities will be summarily removed from the facility.

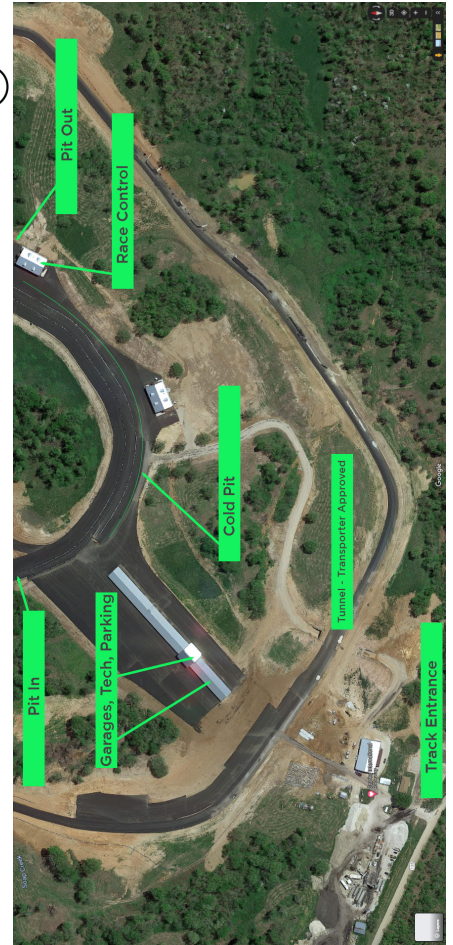
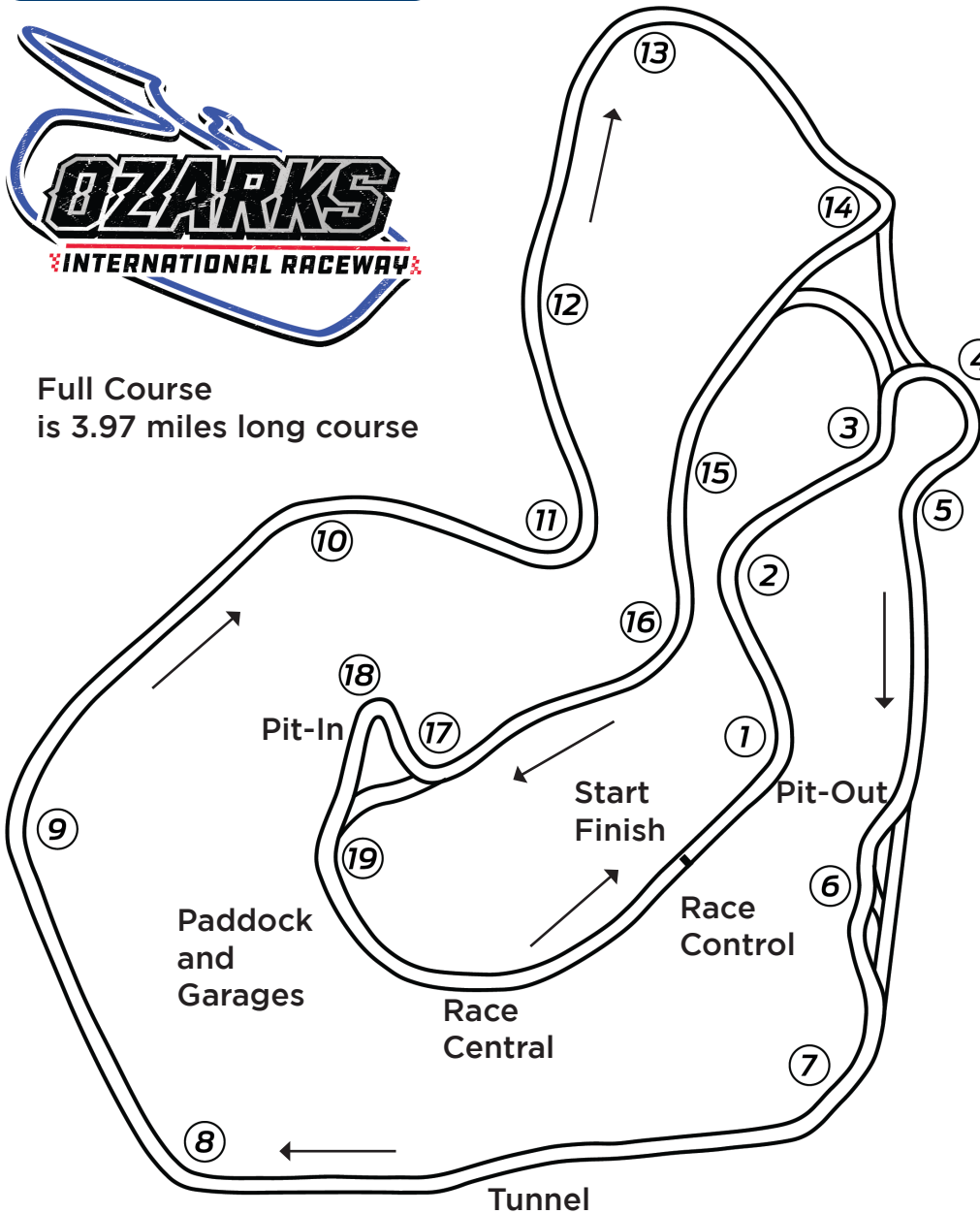
