ESN 1 - Lights are required on the race cars per the BCCR.

ESN 2 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR by the facility. Mufflers are required at Thompson Speedway.

ESN 3 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage.

ESN 4 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 5 - Flagtronics & Transponders will be available for rent at \$50 each per event weekend. Available at Race Central / Registration.

Technical Information

ATTENTION: All vehicles, drivers, and crew must meet the safety and equipment requirements of the [2024 BCCR](#). Stint maximum of 2 hours per driver with a minimum of 1 hour between stints.

All fueling is to be completed on pitlane race day.

Driver & Crew Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband and helmet decal from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form. The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration. Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics FT-200 serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display: Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar> Code35 will be in use at all ChampCar events. As ChampCar test the timing and scoring capabilities with the Flagtronics FT-200, it is imperative that your FT200 unit and the GPS is mounted within the rules and that the unit is working.

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft. There are homes on track left.

Alcohol: Absolutely no alcohol may be consumed in the Paddock during the day's racing events. Alcoholic beverages are permitted in the paddocks and pits 15 minutes after on-track activities has ceased for the day until 10pm.

Venue Specific Information

NOTE: Testing, tuning, brake bedding, high speed accelerations or braking will be limited to the track, and not allowed in the paddock or surround public roadways. Doing so could result in event expulsion with no fees returned.

Quiet Time: 10:00pm to 6:00am. Unmuffled engines can not be started before 8am. ALL ChampCars are required to have mufflers per the BCCR.

Clothing / Shorts: Shorts are not permitted on pit lane (in hot pits) during racing events. Open toed shoes are not allowed on pit lane while the track is hot.

Bridge: The lights on either side of the bridge allowing ingress and egress to the paddock are on a timer. The lights will change approximately every 90 seconds, and must be obeyed.

Paddock Flow: The traffic flow in the paddock is counterclockwise. In other words, when traveling in the garage area the building should stay to the driver's left. In addition, cords may not run across the travel lane during on-track activity. Cords being run while the track is cold must be covered by a yellow jacket cable protector.

2024 Tech Inspection: Please complete your Web-based tech form and the car ready for safety inspection by ChampCar tech staff. Please have your number panels installed. All teams will be given new 2024 sponsor panels. They must be installed at Tech.

Sound: Thompson Speedway does have sound limits for race cars. For this event we will enforce the ChampCar BCCR 96dBa at 50 feet. You will get black flagged if you exceed 96 dBa and must make the car meet the sound level before you are allowed to re-enter the track. Put a muffler or two on your race car and you should not have any issues. Thompson has sound meters that will be used along side ChampCar meters.

Test & Tune Information: Test days for Champcar Endurance Series. You MUST be competing in the event following the Test Day in order to register. Any cancellations MUST be received by calling Catriona at the speedway office 860-923-2280 no later than 24 hours in advance to receive a refund. \$250 fee for the test day. <http://www.thompsonspeedway.com/reservations> Click "Test Days" Click on August 23rd on the calendar. Click test Day. Then click on "BOOK NOW".

Garages: Garage spaces are 16' wide and approximately 30' deep. Garages may be booked Online up to 2 days in advance. If it is within 2 days of an event, please call the TSMP office at 860-923-2280 in order to reserve a garage. If it is within 24 hours of the event all available stalls will be first come first

serve on site the day of the event. Garages are \$60 per day. <http://www.thompsons Speedway.com/reservations>

Garage rental check-in is available at the Guest Registration building at the main entrance upon arrival. You will receive a sticker that must be displayed on your windshield for garage access.

Cancellations must be made at least two days before the event in order to receive a refund.

Fueling is not permitted in the garage area at any time. All fuel

cans must be left outside the garage at all times – regardless of whether full or not.

Camping / Camper Hookups: Teams may use self-contained campers in their paddock spaces. Traditional camping spaces are available just inside the main gate. You must vacate the track on Saturday by 10:00pm.

Paddock / Pitlane Electric: No power on pit lane and limited power in the paddock.

Lighting: Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for night time mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources.

Weekend Membership Passes: Cannot go over the wall, \$20 for the weekend at registration. Over the wall crew must be full ChampCar club members. 16 and under free with parent or guardian. Children under 18 are not allowed on the cold or hot pit lane. ChampCar officials will be policing for proper credentials.

Pets: Pets must remain on leashes and under the direct control of their owners at all times. No pets on pit-lane.

Barbecues: Subject to change due to fire season. No open campfires or barrel fires are allowed. Only contained, manufactured barbecues and grills are permitted. BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Children: Children must be under the supervision of a parent or guardian at all times. No small children on pit-lane. Children under the age of sixteen (16) are not permitted to drive golf carts or operate any other motorized vehicles at TSMP. This applies to all golf carts, whether used from TSMP or privately owned.

Restroom / Showers: Restrooms and showers are available in the paddock.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage

Concessions: The Food Truck will be open for the event.

Fuel on site: Sunoco Racing Fuels are available 24/7 at the track Sunoco Fuel Station. 93 Unleaded, 260 GTX (98 Unleaded), 110 Leaded, 112 Leaded.

Fluid Disposal: Fluid wastes must be placed in approved TSMP disposal containers located at various sites in the paddocks and NEVER on the ground.

Junk and Parts: Left Behind: All competitors will be responsible for the removal cost of any waste, hazardous material or otherwise, including, but not limited to fuel, oil or tires left on the premises by the any participants.

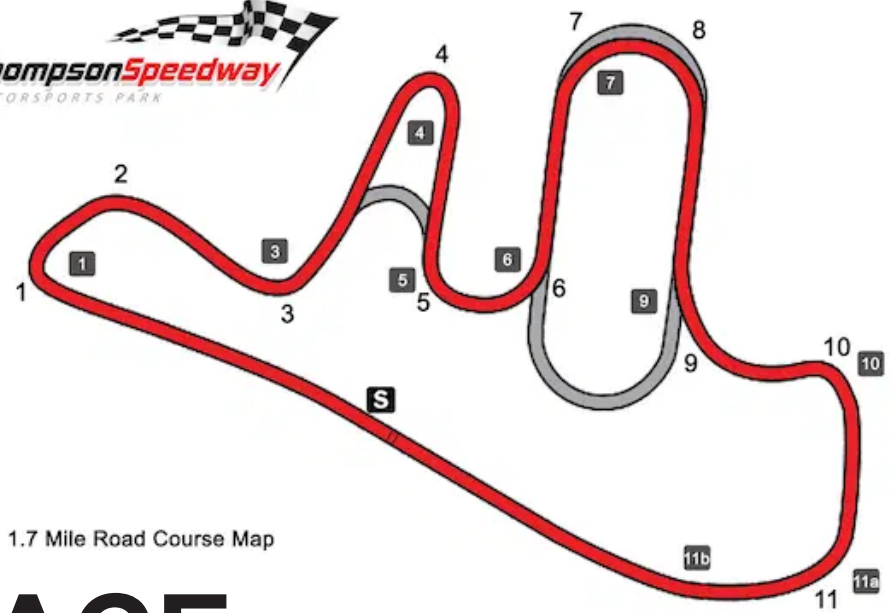
