EVENT SPECIAL NOTICES

ESN 1 - Lights are required on the race cars per the BCCR. Lights may be required to be on during inclement weather.

ESN 2 - Max sound of 96dbA at 50-feet will be enforced per the BCCR.

ESN 3 - Track damage fees will be passed onto the team responsible for the damage. Track limits will be enforced.

ESN 4 - Teams using the ESS Fire Bottle must remove them from the car and take them to Tech to have them weighed/inspected.

ESN 5 - Flagtronics will be available for rent at \$50 per event weekend. Available at Race Central / Registration.

ESN 6 - All tires used in the ChampCar Endurance Series must have an original molded tread depth of 7/32 inches or more. Tires molded with less tread depth will not be permitted.

ESN 7 - Passenger seat must be removed for the race.

ESN 8 - Quiet Time- 8:00pm - 8:00am. No race engines!

ESN 9 - Test day is held by Pitt Race.

Technical Information

ATTENTION: All vehicles, drivers, and crew must meet the safety and equipment requirements of the [2024 BCCR](#).

Stint maximum of 2 hours per driver with a minimum of 1 hour between stints.

All fueling is to be completed on pitlane race day. Absolutely no fueling in the garages. Do not store fuel in the garages.

Driver & Crew Waiver and Gear Check Agreement: Log into your membership portal and complete the Waiver. Once that is completed, continue to the Gear Check Agreement and complete it. Once done, you can collect your event wristband from registration. This waiver and agreement are done once a year.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics FT-200 serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:

Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Code35 will be in use at all ChampCar events.

As ChampCar test the timing and scoring capabilities with the Flagtronics FT-200, it is imperative that your FT200 unit and the GPS is mounted within the rules and that the unit is working.

Fire Bottle: Teams using the ESS brand on-board fire suppression system must remove the bottle from the car and take it to the Tech Inspection area to have them weighed and inspected. This must be done at all events entered.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

Alcohol: Absolutely no alcohol may be consumed in the during the day's racing events.

NOTE: Testing, tuning, brake bedding, high speed accelerations or braking will be limited to the track, and not allowed in the paddock or surrounding public roadways. Doing so could result in event expulsion with no fees returned.

2024 Tech Inspection: Please complete your Web-based tech form and the car ready for safety inspection by ChampCar tech staff. Please have your Number / Sponsor panels installed. All teams will be given new 2024 sponsor panels. They must be installed at Tech.

No Passengers Allowed.

\$275 per car for ½ day (Afternoon sessions ONLY) - There is a \$30 walk-up fee if you do not pre register.

This event will run from 12:30 pm until 5:30 pm with alternating sessions between run groups. This is one hour longer than a normal afternoon Test and Tune to allow for more ChampCar drivers to rotate through practice. On-track incidents, mechanical delays and adverse weather are unpredictable and could result in reduced track time. To be clear, your registration is for one run group, not both. If you are registering a ChampCar, it can only run in the ChampCar group. You cannot use that car in the non-ChampCar group. However, you may register for the other run group with a different car that meets the eligibility requirements of that group.

- Driver Check-In begins at 10 am followed by a mandatory driver's meeting at 11:45 am If you arrive after the drivers meeting you must see the lead instructor before you will be given access to the track.
- No race engines may be started before 8 am or after 8 pm You will be asked to shut off your engine and it may result in a penalty with reduced track time for your vehicle.
- Pitt Race determines the schedule and run groups based on enrollment. In the interest of safety, Pitt Race reserves the right to limit the number of participants on the track at any time.

Garages: If you are interested in renting a garage or an electric supplied paddock spot for this event please call the track at 724-535-1000. Please note that this is a separate reservation from the weekend rental you may have scheduled with another organization. Reservations must be paid for at the time of booking.

Paddock: Paddock on the asphalt only, do not park vehicles on the grass or "no parking" zones. No vehicle testing, brake bedding, etc. on paddock roads or the skid pad area. Pit bikes, golf carts, side-by-sides must be operated by a licensed driver. Paddock speed limit is 15mph.

Paddock Electric: Limited, bring generators.

Pitlane Electric: None. Bring generators.

Paddock: Speed limit is restricted to 20 mph in all areas of the facility.

Weekend Membership Passes: Cannot go over the wall, \$20 for the weekend at registration. Over the wall crew must be full ChampCar club members.

Pets: While Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course does not encourage bringing pets to the track, we do allow them. Pets are the responsibility of the pet owner. Pet owners are liable for any injury or damage caused by their pets. All pets must be kept under the control of a leash no longer than 6 ft. Please be courteous and clean up after your pet. Failure to do so will result in removal from the event. Pets are not permitted in any buildings, concession areas, grandstands or viewing mounds, hospitality locations, paddock/garage areas, false grid, or pit lane. Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course reserves the right to restrict/remove disruptive or exotic pets. If your pet disrupts or causes harm to another individual or property, you and your pet may be removed from the facility without a refund.

Children: No children under-18 allowed on pit road.

Camping / Camper Hookups: Teams may use self-contained campers in their paddock spaces.

Do not nail tent or awning legs to the asphalt.

Wood or other weight displacement materials must be used under all trailer or RV landing/leveling gear.

The pre-reserved electrical power spots are for those customers only. It has 50 amp service so have an adapter if your RV runs on 30 amp.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the paddock area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Restrooms and showers are available in the paddock .

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Will be open for this event.

Weather: We're racing, regardless of the weather. Prepare for rain, heat, and high humidity.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions: Yes. Concessions is open during business hours. Friday: 10am-2pm. Sat-Sun - Open Hours may vary.

Fuel on site: Sunoco Racing Fuel is the official fuel of Pitt Race. The following grades are available at the facility pay-at-the-pump station. There is a Sunoco mandated security program in place that will limit you to three transactions on the same card in one day. If you think you will need more fuel, bring more than one card.

Leaded 110 Octane

Unleaded 100 Octane

Premium Unleaded 93 Octane

Fluid Disposal: Fluid wastes must be placed in approved disposal containers located at various sites in the paddocks and NEVER on the ground.

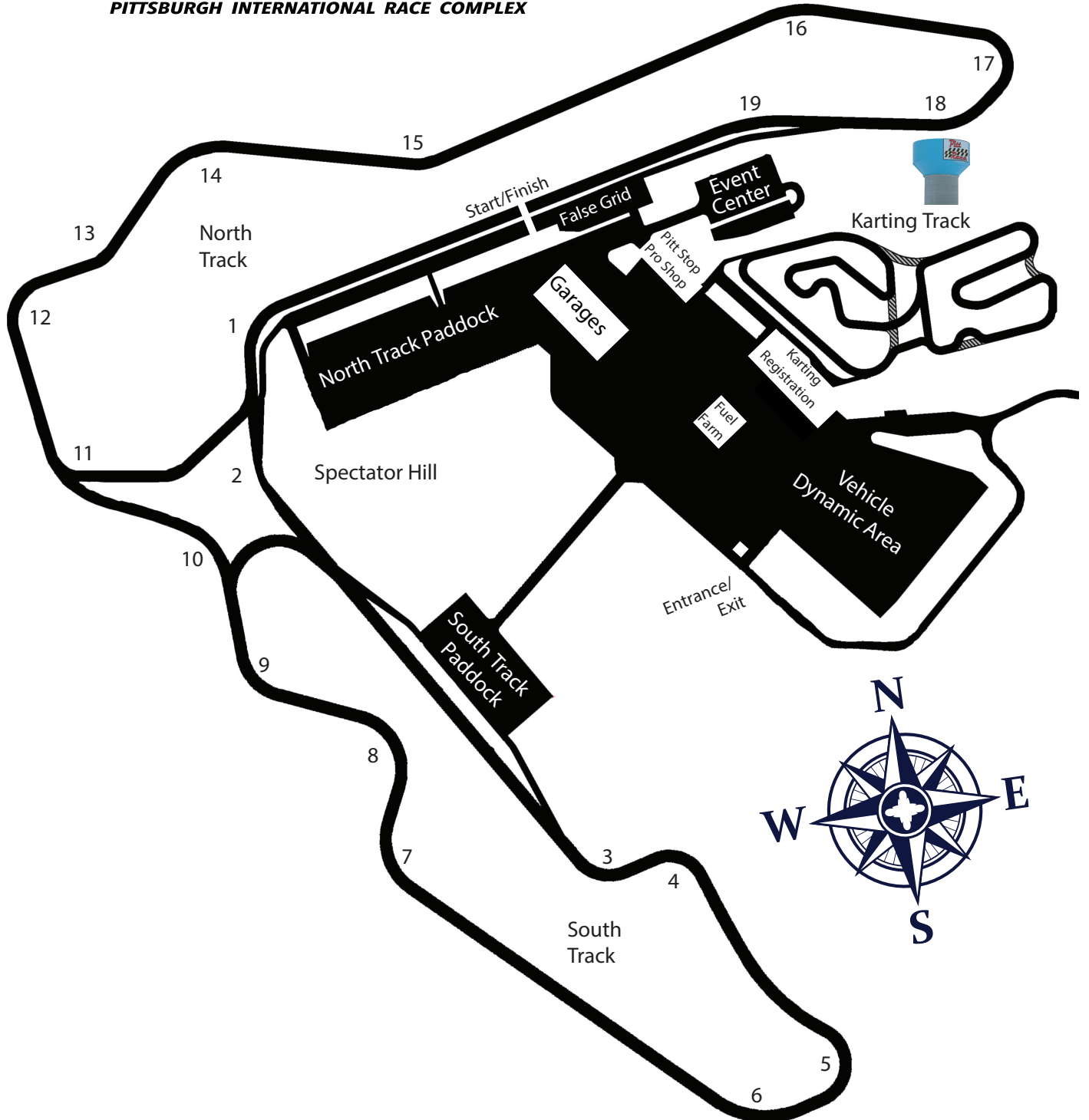
