## Event Info

### Technical Information

**ATTENTION:** All vehicles, drivers, and crew must meet the safety and equipment requirements of the [2025 BCCR](#). Stint maximum of 2 hours per driver with a minimum of 1 hour between stints.

All fueling is to be completed on pitlane race day.

**Race Car Tech Inspection:** All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The team captain will log in here <https://champcar.org/register/login.php> to complete the race car online tech form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics FT-200 serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

**Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:**

Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Code35 will be in use at all ChampCar events.

As ChampCar test the timing and scoring capabilities with the Flagtronics FT-200, it is imperative that your FT200 unit and the GPS is mounted within the rules and that the unit is working.

**Sound:** Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

**Alcohol:** Absolutely no alcohol may be consumed in the Paddock during the day's racing events. Alcohol may be consumed 30 minutes following the completion of on-track activity for the day.

### Venue Specific Information

**NOTE:** Testing, tuning, brake bedding, high speed accelerations or braking will be limited to the track, and not allowed in the paddock or surround public roadways. Doing so could result in event expulsion with no fees returned.

**2024 Tech Inspection:** Please complete your Web-based tech form and the car ready for safety inspection by ChampCar tech staff. Please have your number panels installed. All teams will be given new 2024 sponsor panels. They must be installed at Tech.

**Test & Tune Information:** From 12-noon to 6:00pm Harris Hill Raceway will administer a Test/Practice Session. The event fee is \$250. Arrangements and management of the Test/Practice session is through the track. Please make sure you bring your car through ChampCar Tech and Registration during the day.

**Paddock:** Due to limited space and a very cozy paddock, we have to limit the number of "big rigs" at the track. We have 8 spaces for larger RVs and Toy-Haulers and you must reserve a space in advance on a first come, first served basis. These will remain up top around the clubhouse parking area. You must also check in upon arrival and an H2R staff member will help you place your rig in the right spot. **No single vehicle (Trailer or Tow Vehicle) measuring longer than 28 feet may remain in the paddock and adjacent grassy areas.** Support vehicles may drop off fuel etc. to your paddock space and then return to the clubhouse area. For this the "driveway" must be used (**absolutely NO driving in the grass is permitted except for parking on the south side of the "driveway"**). No Parking in the "driveway" is allowed – it must be kept clear for support vehicle and pedestrian traffic. We'll also have designated storage/parking for trailers or tow vehicles up top if you need more elbow room in the paddock. Please give Harris Hill a call at 512-667-6250 to reserve one of the RV spots or if you have any questions.

**Paddock Electric:** None

**Pitlane Electric & Heaters:** None. Bring generators.

**Pitlane Speed:** 10 MPH in the paddock. While on pit lane, if you exceed 35mph while the course is under code35, you will be penalized for speeding.

**Radio Frequencies:** The ChampCar radio frequencies are reserved for ChampCar official use only and must not be used by the track or teams during the event. Monitor the [Race Logs](#)

**Lighting:** The pit lanes has zero lighting. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit area are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures. **Do NOT fuel under your easy-up.**

## Event Info

### Venue Specific Information

**Pavement and Wastes:** Do not drive stakes into the pavement. Always use wood blocks or metal plates to prevent pavement damage from jacks and jack stands. Do not spill oil, coolant, or fuel onto pavement or ground. Receptacles for waste oil and for coolant are available in the tech shed. Please make provision for removing from the premises any used tires, fuel, brake fluid, solvents, hazardous waste products, and batteries. If you do have an accidental spill, please contact any ChampCar official.

**Clothing:** Closed toed shoes are required in all areas of the paddock.

**Guest & Pit Passes:** All people go into the paddock area must be full ChampCar Club Members. Guests may purchase a weekend membership to ChampCar at the front gate for \$20. This will give you paddock access. 16 and under free with parent or guardian, and must remain up by the club house. Children under 18 are not allowed in the paddock area.

**Pets:** They are welcome on property, but must be kept on a leash. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets and must dispose of their waste properly. Pets are not allowed in the paddock area.

**Children:** No children under-18 allowed in the paddock area. All minor drivers and crew must complete the ChampCar and Venue minor waivers. See race director for more info.

**Camping:** Self-contained RV camping is allowed Friday & Saturday night. Must be out by 6pm Sunday.

**Camping / Camper Hookups:** There are no hookups.

**Barbecues:** BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

**Restroom / Showers:** Yes. / No. Restroom is in the Club House. There are no showers.

**Gate:** 24-hour gate coverage.

**Concessions:** Open Saturday, and Sunday in the clubhouse.

**Fuel on site:** None.

**Drones:** Unmanned aircraft systems and drones are prohibited at ChampCar Endurance events at all times.

**Other Restrictions:** Golf Carts - Race Support Vehicles: NO ONE UNDER 16 MAY DRIVE SUPPORT VEHICLES at Harris Hill Raceway.

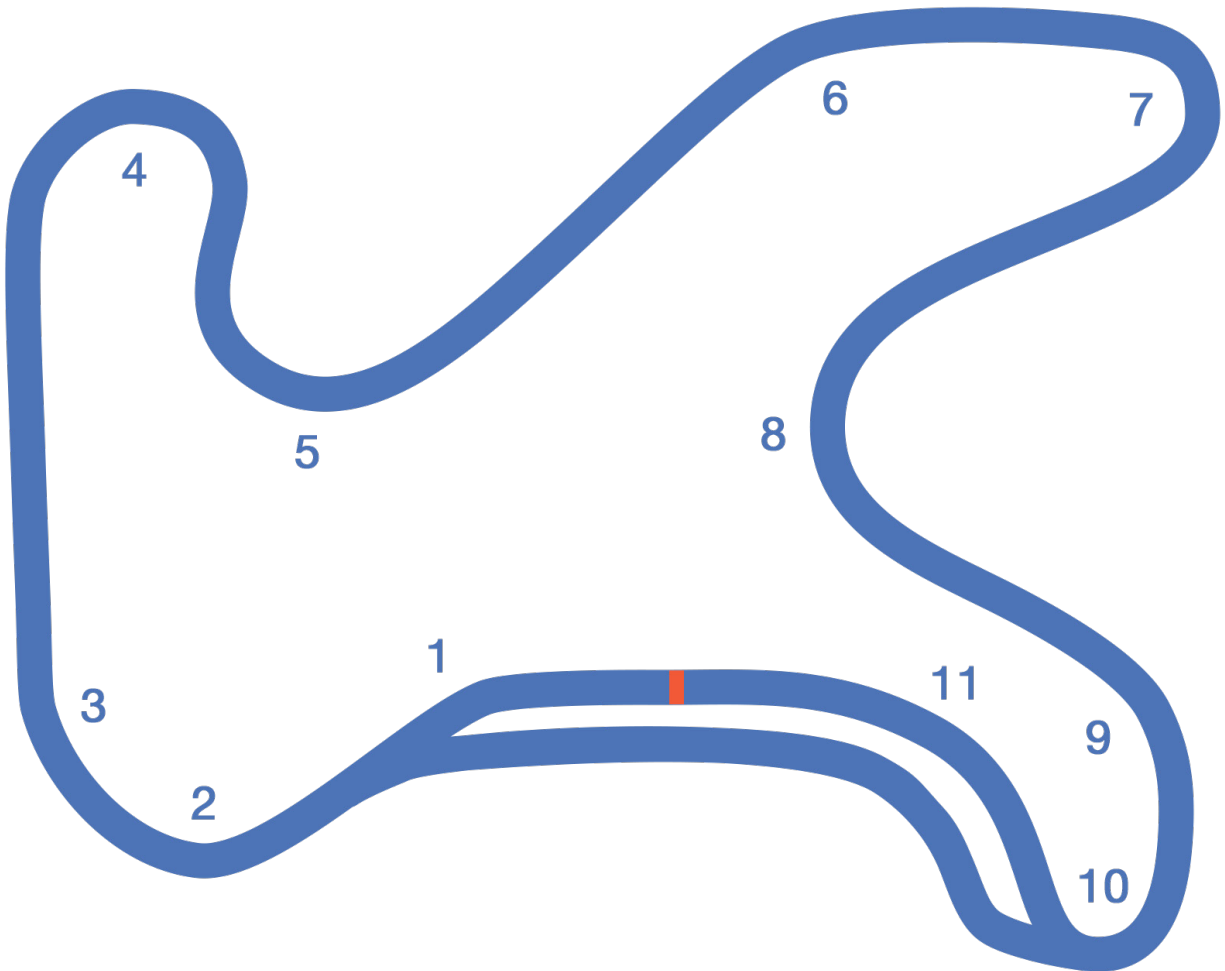
