Technical Information

ATTENTION: All vehicles, drivers, and crew must meet the safety and equipment requirements of the [2025 BCCR](#). Stint maximum of 2 hours per driver with a minimum of 1 hour between stints.

All fueling is to be completed on pitlane race day.

Race Car Tech Inspection: All teams will be required to do the On-line Tech Form.

The team captain will log in here <https://champcar.org/register/login.php> to complete the race car online tech form.

The Team Captain will find a button link on your main login page. Three months before the race, the tab "Submit a Tech Form" will take you to an electronic form that looks just like the paper Tech Inspection form. Simply fill in all the boxes at the top, then fill in or click on the listed point value items on your car. Save the form and you are done. At the track the Tech staff will simply check the required safety items on the car. Once the Tech staff clicks save on the safety portion of your online form you will get your annual tech sticker and head to ChampCar registration.

Please verify your timing & scoring transponder and Flagtronics FT-200 serial numbers, and make certain to add your car class to the tech form.

Flagtronics FT200 Wireless Flagging Display:

Limited quantities of units may be available to rent. Rental fee is \$50 for the event. You may purchase your own FT200 unit at <https://flagtronics.com/champcar>

Code35 will be in use at all ChampCar events.

As ChampCar test the timing and scoring capabilities with the Flagtronics FT-200, it is imperative that your FT200 unit and the GPS is mounted within the rules and that the unit is working.

Sound: Sound readings will take place throughout the weekend. All ChampCars are required to have mufflers, and not exceed 96dBa at 50ft.

Alcohol: Absolutely no alcohol may be consumed in the Paddock during the day's racing events. Alcohol may be consumed 30 minutes following the completion of on-track activity for the day.

Venue Specific Information

Quiet Times: No race engines may run before 7:30am or after 8pm.

No loud music is permitted after 10 pm. Be considerate of neighbors. Camping quiet time begins at 10 pm. Sunday Quiet Time: in observance of local church services, the track shall observe quiet time on Sunday from 11am to 12pm. Absolutely NO race engines may be run during this time.

Test and Tune Information: ChampCar Test Day. 250 for ChampCars. \$350 for Non-ChampCar Caged cars (Must be full \$75 members)

Paddock & Paddock Speed Limit: 10 MPH

No parking, repairing, or refueling vehicles or placing scales or jack stands on any paddock road. These access roads are considered an Emergency Fire Lane by the Fire Marshall. All tires, broken fiberglass, scrap metal, batteries, and any other parts which have been removed or fallen off cars must be removed from Carolina Motorsports Park.

Pit Lane Speed Limit: 20 MPH

Garages: Garages are reserved through CMP website. Do not store gasoline inside of the garages. <https://carolinamotorsportspark.com/online-reservations/>

Waiver and Wristbands: Only the team captain needs to check in at registration to receive driver and crew credentials. More information will be available as we get closer to the event.

Pitlane Electric: None. Bring a generator.

Lighting: The paddock has minimal area lighting. Be advised that ambient lighting may not be sufficient for mechanical repairs. Therefore, teams are advised to consider alternate power and lighting sources. The use of EZ-ups on the "cold" side of the pit wall are also recommended for keeping out weather and hanging all lighting fixtures.

Motorized Vehicles: No pit bikes, dirt bikes or minibikes are allowed on the premises without prior approval from the track manager.

Facility and Facility Lake: No fishing or swimming in the lake. The lake is off limits to ALL activities. No climbing or jumping ANY fences. Do not damage any grassy area in any manner.

Venue Specific Information

Environmental: All trash must be placed in the receptacles provided. Environmentally hazardous waste MUST be disposed of in appropriate receptacles. Any spill MUST be reported to CMP staff for immediate clean up.

Please dump waste oil into yellow 55-gallon drums marked "OIL". Please dump anti-freeze into blue 55-gallon drums marked "ANTI-FREEZE".

Do not dump race fuel into recycling drums. You shall be billed the disposal fee for contaminated liquids. Fuel cannot be sold at the track or pre-sold for delivery to the track. Do not pour gasoline, oil, antifreeze, or other fluids on the ground.

You shall be billed for any items left at the track that must be disposed of by a disposal company (i.e. tires, batteries, fuel barrels, etc.).

Weekend Memberships: Weekend memberships can be purchased for \$20 at ChampCar Race Central.

Pets: All pet animals must be leashed or confined. Owners are responsible for their behavior, damages, and clean-ups. Pets are not allowed in any of the buildings, concession area, false grid, or pit area at any time.

Children: Minor waivers for track entrance. No one under 16 allowed to operate golf carts, pit wagons, or any powered vehicle.

Camping / Camper Hookups: Camping spaces with 30amp power are pre-reserved through the CMP website. Camping quiet time begins at 10 pm. No loud music is permitted. Be considerate of neighbors. Campfires are only allowed in fire pits which contain and lift the fire off the ground. 20amp power is available in some additional spaces, all 20amp and non-powered camping spaces are first-come firstchoice.

Barbecues: BBQ's are allowed in the camping area only, provided all BBQ's are supervised at all times, a fire extinguisher is within 15' of the open flame, and all open flames are (at a minimum) 20' from all race cars, fuel storage or other flammable sources.

Restroom / Showers: Yes. / Yes.

Gate: 24-hour gate coverage.

Concessions:

8am-3pm Friday through Sunday

Fuel on site: CMP offers Sunoco race fuel at the pumps and a couple octanes in 5 gallon pails. CMP fuel offering is as follows: <https://carolinamotorsportspark.com/fuel/>

There is also a mini-mart that sells pump gas out side of the facility gate. This is currently under construction. They may be open by race time.

All fees will include a 4% ChampCar Processing fee



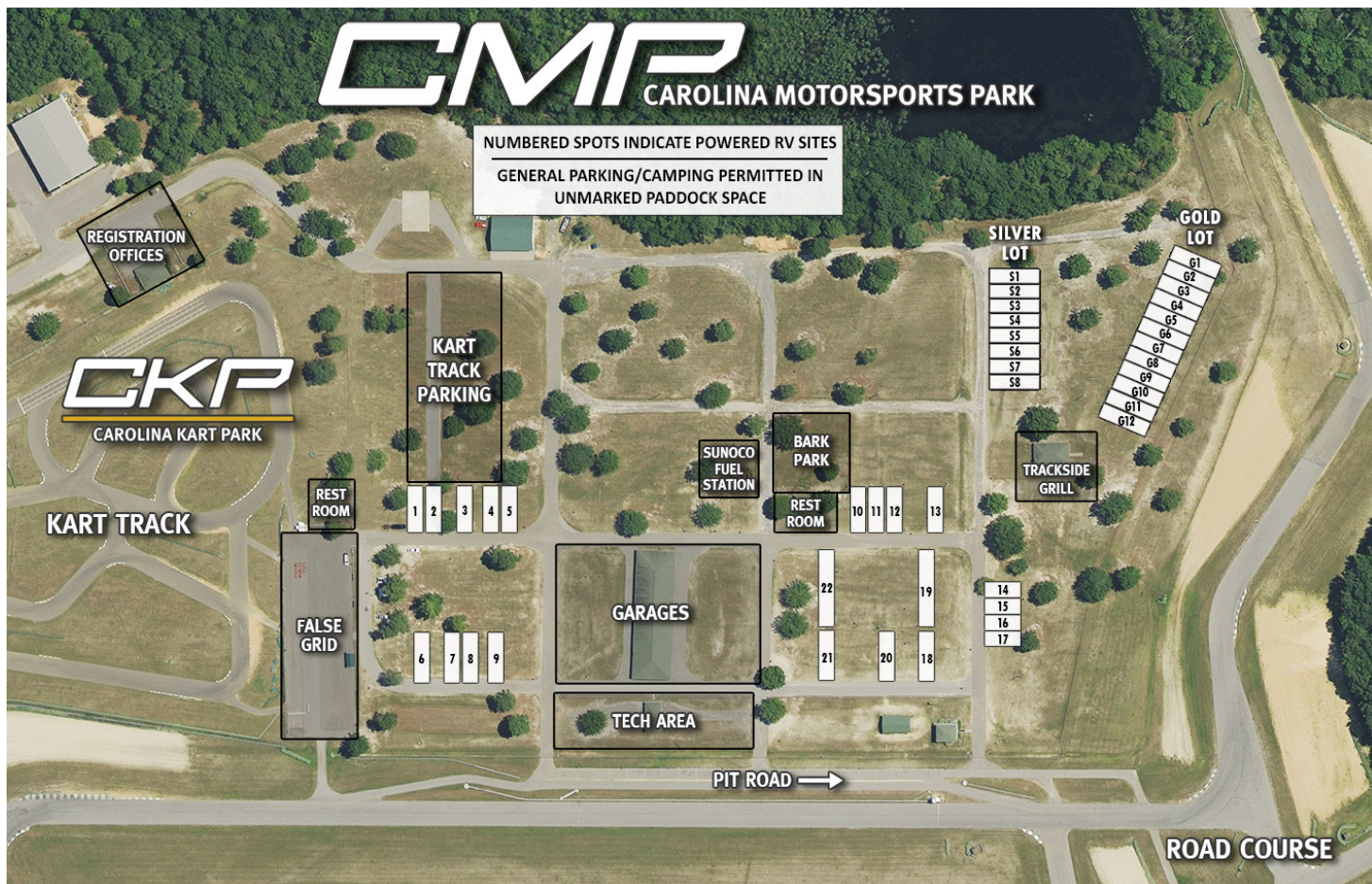

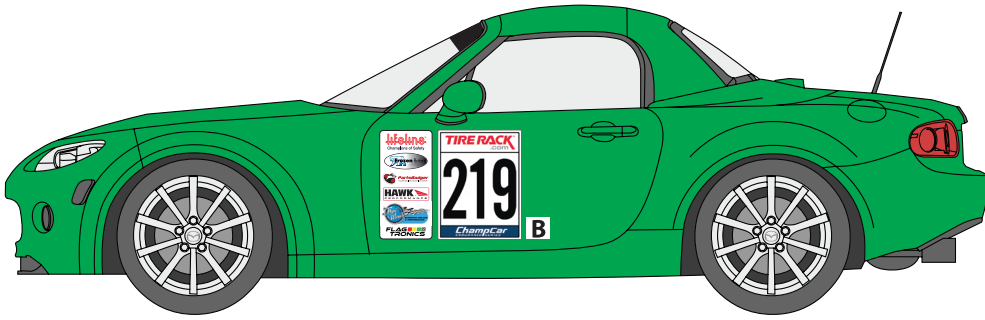
